ORDINANCE No. 2172

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 1, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 7, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY PROVIDING THAT THE MAXIMUM PUNISHMENT FOR A VIOLATION OF ANY SECTION OF THIS CODE SHALL BE SIX MONTHS IN JAIL OR A FINE OF ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS OR BOTH AND REPEALS TITLE 1, CHAPTER 3 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, IN ITS ENTIRETY.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS,
NEVADA DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 1, Chapter 1, Section 7, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

1-1-7: GENERAL PENALTY: Whenever in this Code or in any ordinance of the City any act is prohibited or is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, or whenever in such Code or ordinance the doing of any act is required or the failure to do any act is declared to be unlawful, when no specific penalty is provided therefor, the violation of any such provision of this Code or any ordinance shall be punished by a fine not exceeding [five hundred dollars (\$500.00)] one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisonment for a term not exceeding six (6) months, or both such fine and imprisonment. Each day any violation of any provision of this Code or of any ordinance shall continue shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 2: Title 1, Chapter 3, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby
