

ORDINANCE NO. 941

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE X, CHAPTER 17 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960, BY AMENDING SECTION 11 TO PROVIDE THAT THE PERIOD FOR PARKING A VEHICLE WITHIN AN ALLEY BE LIMITED TO THIRTY (30) MINUTES ONLY; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 11 of Chapter 17, Title X of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960, is hereby amended to read as follows:

PARKING IN ALLEYS: No person shall park a vehicle within an alley in such manner or under such conditions as to leave available less than ten (10) feet of the width of the roadway for the free movement of vehicular traffic, and no person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle within an alley in such position as to block the driveway entrance to any abutting property. A vehicle properly parked in the alley shall not stand for a greater period than thirty (30) minutes at any time.

SECTION 2. All ordinances, parts of ordinances, chapters, sections, subsections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00, or by imprisonment in the City Jail for not more than six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

ORDINANCE NO. 611

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE X, CHAPTER 17 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960, BY AMENDING SECTION 11 TO PROVIDE THAT THE PERIOD FOR PARKING A VEHICLE WITHIN AN ALLEY BE LIMITED TO THIRTY (30) MINUTES ONLY; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do ordain as follows: SECTION 1. Section 11 of Chapter 17, Title X of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960, is hereby amended to read as follows:

PARKING IN ALLEYS: No person shall park a vehicle within an alley in such manner or under such conditions as to leave available less than ten (10) feet of the width of the roadway for the free movement of vehicular traffic, and no person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle within an alley in such position as to block the driveway entrance to any abutting property. A vehicle properly parked in the alley shall not stand for a greater period than thirty (30) minutes at any time.

SECTION 2. All ordinances, parts of ordinances, chapters, sections, subsections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00, or by imprisonment in the City Jail for not more than six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
