

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE I, CHAPTER 18, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960, BY AMENDING THE CIVIL SERVICE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, COUNTY OF CLARK, STATE OF NEVADA, FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF SAID CITY; PROVIDING FOR AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 920 THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR A SECTION 1, 2 and 3 of SECTION 920; PROVIDING FOR A RETIREMENT AGE; PROVIDING FOR EXTENSIONS OF RETIREMENT AGE; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 18 of Title I, Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960, is hereby amended by amending Section 920 to provide for three new subsections to read as follows:

920 - Retirement:

- 920.1 All employees except those enumerated in 920.2 shall retire at the age of 65. Such employees may retire at an earlier age if applicable retirement provisions permit.
- 920.2 All commissioned members of the Police and Fire Departments shall retire at the age of 60. Such employees may retire at an earlier age if applicable retirement provisions permit.
- 920.3 In exceptional circumstances the City Manager may, in the interest of the City, extend the retirement ages provided herein, however, not more than a one year extension shall be granted at any one time.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, chapters, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

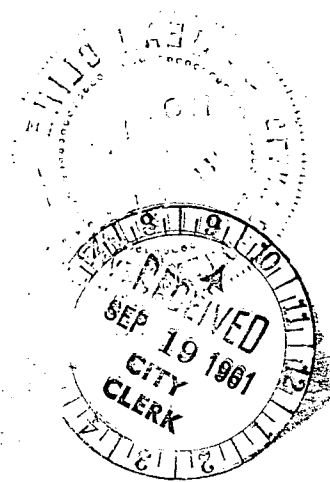
