

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE VI, CHAPTER 2, SECTION 40 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960; BY PROHIBITING THE GIVING AWAY OF ANIMALS, FISH OR REPTILES; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Title VI, Chapter 2, Section 40 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960, is hereby amended to read as follows:

6-2-40 It shall be unlawful for any person, association, partnership, corporation or other entity in connection with any advertising campaign or promotion to give or offer to give as a gift or prize any live animal, reptile, bird or fish of any description whatsoever, or for any concessionaire of any carnival, fair, or other amusement park to use any live animal, reptile, bird or fish as or for a target, or in any unusual manner. Provided, however, this section shall not prohibit the proper display of animals, birds, fish or reptiles in proper facilities for educational purposes.

SECTION 2. Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00, or by imprisonment in the City Jail for not more than six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, chapters, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

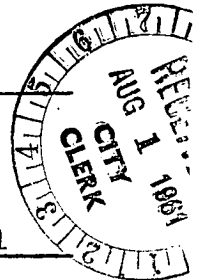
