

ORDINANCE NO. 1329

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE V, CHAPTER 25, SECTION 8 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY PROVIDING FOR THE TYPE SIGN AND SIZE LETTERING THEREON TO BE USED BY WEDDING CHAPELS AND OTHER ESTABLISHMENTS AT WHICH WEDDINGS ARE PERFORMED FOR THE POSTING OF A STATEMENT OF CHARGES FOR SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title V, Chapter 25, Section 8 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

5-25-8: STATEMENT OF WEDDING CHAPEL RATES TO BE POSTED:

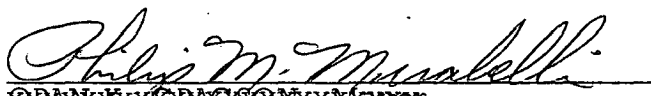
- (A) The owner or operator of any wedding chapel or other establishment at which weddings are performed shall post and maintain in a prominent and conspicuous place in the office or reception room thereof a statement of rates of all charges for services.
- (B) The statement of charges for all services shall be in the form of a printed sign with clearly discernible red lettering on a white background, said lettering to be not less than 3/8" high.
- (C) It shall be unlawful for any wedding chapel or other establishment performing weddings or at which weddings are performed to charge more than the posted rates, or to require a condition of securing services not posted or previously agreed upon by all parties.

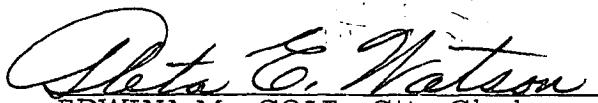
SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the City Jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

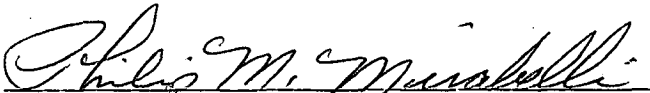

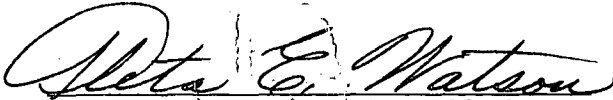

SECTION 1. Title V, Chapter 25,
Section 8 of the Municipal Code of

Edition is hereby amended to read
as follows:

5-25-8. STATEMENT OF WEDDING
CHAPEL RATES TO BE POSTED:

(A) The owner or operator of any
wedding chapel or other estab-
lishment at which weddings are
performed shall post and maintain
in a prominent and conspicuous
place in the office or reception
room thereof a statement of rates
of all charges for services.

(B) The statement of charges for all
services shall be in the form of
a printed sign with clearly dis-
cernible red lettering on a white
background, said lettering to be
not less than 1/4 inch high.

(C) It shall be unlawful for any
wedding chapel or other establish-
ment performing weddings one of
which weddings are performed to
charge more than the posted
rates or to require a condition
of securing services not posted or
previously agreed upon by all
parties.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or
corporation violating any of the
provisions of this ordinance shall, upon
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SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts
of ordinances, sections, subsections,
phrases, sentences, clauses or para-
graphs contained in the Municipal
Code of the City of Las Vegas, Ne-
vada, 1960 Edition, in conflict here-
with are hereby repealed.
