

ORDINANCE NO. 1337

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE XI, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 6 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY ADDING A NEW SUBSECTION, DESIGNATED SUBSECTION (P), PROVIDING BEES OR BEEHIVES SHALL NOT BE MAINTAINED IN ANY ZONING DISTRICT WITH AN "R" PREFIX, EXCEPT IN ZONING DESIGNATIONS CLASSIFIED R-R, R-A AND R-E, PROVIDING SAID BEES OR BEEHIVES SHALL BE A DISTANCE OF TWO HUNDRED FEET (200') FROM ANY OTHER RESIDENCE OR BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH. 1337

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title XI, Chapter 1, Section 6 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection, designated subsection (P), to read as follows:

11-1-6 (P): It shall be unlawful to maintain bees or beehives within any zoning classification in the City of Las Vegas, except zoning classifications designated as R-R, R-A and R-E, provided further, that said bees or beehives shall not be maintained within a distance of two hundred feet (200') from any other residence or business establishment.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

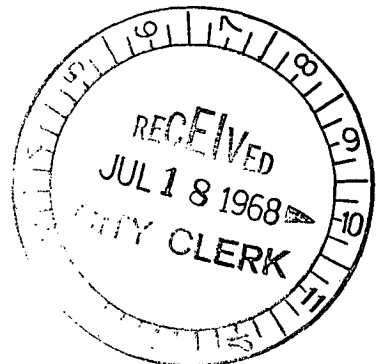

2nd Amendment
AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE XI, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 6 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY ADDING A NEW SUBSECTION, DESIGNATED SUBSECTION (P), PROVIDING BEES OR BEEHIVES SHALL NOT BE MAINTAINED IN ANY ZONING DISTRICT WITH AN "R" PREFIX, EXCEPT IN ZONING DESIGNATIONS CLASSIFIED R-R, R-A AND R-E, PROVIDING SAID BEES OR BEEHIVES SHALL BE A DISTANCE OF TWO HUNDRED FEET (200') FROM ANY OTHER RESIDENCE OR BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT, PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title XI, Chapter 1, Section 6 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection, designated subsection (P), to read as follows:

(P): It shall be unlawful to maintain bees or beehives within any zoning classification in the City of Las Vegas, except zoning classifications designated as R-R, R-A and R-E. Provided further, that said bees or beehives shall not be maintained within a distance of two hundred feet (200') from any other residence or business establishment.

SECTION 2.
