

ORDINANCE NO. 1351

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE X, CHAPTER 8 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY ADDING THERETO TWO NEW SECTIONS, DESIGNATED SECTIONS 4 AND 5, PROVIDING FOR CONTROL OF TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNALS BY EMERGENCY AND TEST VEHICLES USING A FLASHING WHITE LIGHT; TO AMEND TITLE X, CHAPTER 10, SECTION 9 OF SAID MUNICIPAL CODE PROVIDING FOR PROHIBITION AGAINST UNLAWFULLY ATTEMPTING TO OR, IN FACT, CONTROLLING TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES; TO AMEND TITLE X, CHAPTER 13, SECTION 21, SUBSECTION (B) OF SAID MUNICIPAL CODE TO PROVIDE FOR A NEW COLOR DESIGNATION FOR TWO-WAY LEFT TURN LANES; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH. 1351

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title X, Chapter 8 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto two new sections, designated Sections 4 and 5, to read as follows:

10-8-4: TRAFFIC CONTROL BY AUTHORIZED EMERGENCY AND TEST VEHICLE: An authorized emergency vehicle operating under the conditions provided in Section 1 of this chapter or a city test vehicle may display a flashing white light from a gaseous discharge lamp designed and used for the purpose of controlling official traffic control signals.

10-8-5: NON-LIABILITY OF CITY AND EMPLOYEES IN USE OF TRAFFIC SIGNAL CONTROL: Neither the city nor an authorized city employee of the city is responsible for an injury caused by the operation or non-operation of an official traffic controlled signal when controlled by an emergency or test vehicle in accordance with Section 4 of this chapter.

SECTION 2. Title X, Chapter 10, Section 9 of said Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

10-10-9: INTERFERENCE WITH OFFICIAL TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES OR RAILROAD SIGNS OR SIGNALS: No person shall, without lawful authority, attempt to or, in fact, control, alter, deface, injure, knock down, or remove any official traffic control device or any railroad sign or official traffic signal or any inscription, shield or insignia thereon or any other part thereof.

SECTION 3. Title X, Chapter 13, Section 21 of said Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

10-13-21: TWO-WAY TURNING LANES:

- (A) The City Traffic Engineer may designate a two-way left turn lane on a street or highway having two (2) or more lanes for through traffic in each direction. A two-way left turn lane is a lane near the center of the street or highway set aside for use by vehicles making left turns in both directions from or into a street or highway.
- (B) Two-way left turn lanes shall be designated by distinctive roadway markings consisting of a solid outside white line and and inner parallel dashed yellow line on each side of the lane. The City Traffic Engineer may determine and prescribe standards and specifications covering length, width and positioning of the distinctive pavement markings.
- (C) A vehicle shall not be driven in a designated two-way left turn lane except when preparing for or making a left turn. A left turn shall not be made from any other lane where a two-way left turn lane has been designated.

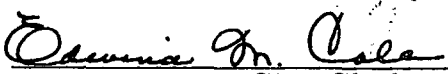
SECTION 4. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

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THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

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SECTION 3. Title X, Chapter 13, Section 21 of said Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

10-13-21:

TWO-WAY TURNING LANES: (A) The City Traffic Engineer may designate a two-way left turn lane on a street or highway having two (2) or more lanes for through traffic in each direction. A two-way left turn lane is a lane near the center of the street or highway set aside for use by vehicles making left turns in both directions from or into a street or highway.

(B) Two-way left turn lanes shall be designated by distinctive roadway markings consisting of a solid outside white line and an inner parallel dashed yellow line on each side of the lane. The City Traffic Engineer may determine and prescribe standards and specifications covering length, width and positioning of the distinctive pavement markings.

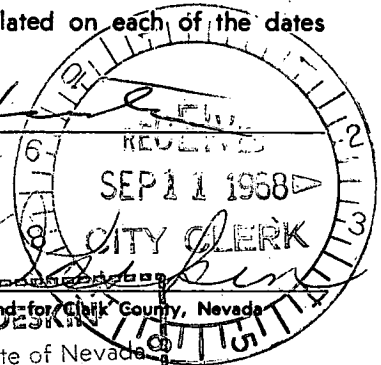
