AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO BUSINESS LICENSE FEES; AMENDING TITLE 6, CHAPTERS 4, 12, 18, 26, 30, 40, 51, 53, 54, 62, 73, AND 84, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, TO REFLECT PERMISSIBLE INCREASES IN BUSINESS LICENSE FEES IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE LAW; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: Increases the semiannual business license fee for specified businesses not falling within that category of business charged a fee based on the gross sales of the business.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY  
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 15, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

**6.04.015:** The license fee for an [account] accountant is [fifty] seventy-five dollars semiannually. Accountant means each certified public accountant and public accountant registered and issued a permit under NRS 628 and conducting a private practice, whether as a sole practitioner or as a partner or associate in a firm, and whether the practice is full-time or supplementary to employment with a Federal, State or local government agency.

SECTION 2: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 17, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

**6.04.017:** The license fee for acupuncture is [fifty] seventy-five dollars semiannually for each person practicing acupuncture, whether a sole practitioner or a member or employee of a firm.

SECTION 3: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 25, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

**6.04.025:** The license fee is [fifty] one hundred dollars semiannually for each advertising

1 business or advertising counsel.

2 SECTION 4: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 30, of the Municipal Code of the  
3 City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 **6.04.030:** The license fee is [two hundred fifty] three hundred dollars semiannually for the  
5 business of leasing or selling outdoor advertising space whether on billboard or  
6 electrical signs, if such business is not required to have a State contractor's license.

7 SECTION 5: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 45, of the Municipal Code of the  
8 City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

9 **6.04.045:** The license fee is [fifty] seventy-five dollars semiannually for all architects  
10 registered and certified by the Nevada State Board of Architecture and conducting  
11 a private practice, whether as a sole practitioner or as a partner or associate in a  
12 firm, and whether the practice is full time or supplementary to employment with  
13 a Federal, State or local government agency.

14 SECTION 6: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 55, of the Municipal Code of the  
15 City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

16 **6.04.055:** The license fee for an assayer is [fifty] seventy-five dollars semiannually.

17 SECTION 7: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 65, of the Municipal Code of the  
18 City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

19 **6.04.065:** The license fee is [fifty] seventy-five dollars semiannually for each attorney  
20 admitted to the Nevada State Bar and conducting a private practice, whether as a  
21 sole practitioner or a partner, shareholder, member, associate or employee in a  
22 firm, and whether the practice is full-time or supplementary to employment with  
23 a Federal, State or local government agency.

24 SECTION 8: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 75, of the Municipal Code of the  
25 City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

26 **6.04.075:** The license fee is [fifty] seventy-five dollars semiannually for each business leasing

1 automobiles or any other kind of motor vehicle.

2 SECTION 9: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 85, of the Municipal Code of the  
3 City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 **6.04.085:** The license fee is [fifty] seventy-five dollars semiannually for each automobile  
5 towing service. This Section shall not apply to service stations and garages which,  
6 as an incident to providing repairs, tow automobiles to their place of business to  
7 make such repairs.

8 SECTION 10: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 90, of the Municipal Code of the  
9 City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

10 **6.04.090:** The license fee is [fifty] one hundred dollars semiannually for each bail bond  
11 broker or bail bond brokerage business, after a State license has been acquired.

12 SECTION 11: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 100, of the Municipal Code of  
13 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

14 **6.04.100:** The license fee is [two hundred fifty] five hundred dollars semiannually for each  
15 main banking facility of each bank as that term is defined in NRS 657.016 and  
16 each branch facility thereof.

17 SECTION 12: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 115, of the Municipal Code of  
18 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

19 **6.04.115:** The license fee for billiard or pool halls is [twenty-five dollars semiannually for the  
20 first noncoin-operated billiard table or pool table and twelve dollars and fifty cents  
21 semiannually for each additional noncoin-operated billiard table or pool table]  
22 twenty-five dollars per billard or pool table.

23 SECTION 13: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 120, of the Municipal Code of  
24 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

25 **6.04.120:** The license fee is [fifty] sixty dollars semiannually for each person other than a  
26 certified public accountant or public accountant who conducts a bookkeeping

1 business for two or more persons or who prepares or assists in preparing income  
2 tax returns for two or more persons other than himself.

3 SECTION 14: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 130, of the Municipal Code of  
4 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

5 **6.04.130:** The license fee for a bowling alley is twenty-five dollars [semiannually for the first  
6 alley and twelve dollars and fifty cents semiannually for each additional alley] per  
7 alley.

8 SECTION 15: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 145, of the Municipal Code of  
9 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

10 **6.04.145:** The license fee is [fifty] seventy-five dollars semiannually for each shorthand  
11 reporter or court reporter holding a certificate of registration under NRS 656.

12 SECTION 16: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 150, of the Municipal Code of  
13 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

14 **6.04.150:** The license fee is [fifty] seventy-five dollars semiannually for every chiropractor  
15 holding a valid State license under NRS 634 and conducting a private practice,  
16 whether as a sole practitioner or as a partner or associate in a firm, and whether  
17 the practice is full time or supplementary to employment with a Federal, State, or  
18 local government agency.

19 SECTION 17: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 160, of the Municipal Code of  
20 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

21 **6.04.160:** The license fee is [fifty] one hundred fifty dollars semiannually for each collection  
22 agency holding a State license under NRS 649.

23 SECTION 18: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 165, of the Municipal Code of  
24 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

25 **6.04.165:** The license fee is [two hundred fifty] three hundred thirty dollars semiannually for  
26 each establishment engaged in the business of effecting transactions in commodity

1 options as defined by [NRS 90.042] NRS 91.100, whether as broker-dealers,  
2 agents, or issuers as such terms are defined in [NRS 90] NRS 91.

3 SECTION 19: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 170, of the Municipal Code of  
4 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

5 **6.04.170:** The license fee is [one hundred] one hundred twenty-five dollars semiannually for  
6 each person required by NRS 624 to have a State contractor's license. A City  
7 contractor's license shall not be issued or renewed until and unless such person has  
8 in effect a valid State contractor's license.

9 SECTION 20: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 178, of the Municipal Code of  
10 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

11 **6.04.178:** The license fee is [fifty] one hundred fifty dollars semiannually for each credit  
12 bureau and each branch office thereof.

13 SECTION 21: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 180, of the Municipal Code of  
14 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

15 **6.04.180:** The license fee is [fifty] three hundred dollars semiannually for each credit union  
16 and each branch office thereof.

17 SECTION 22: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 185, of the Municipal Code of  
18 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

19 **6.04.185:** The license fee is [fifty] seventy-five dollars semiannually for each person who by  
20 contract supplies his own employees to perform only temporary labor services for  
21 another under circumstances in which the individuals performing the labor do not  
22 become employees of the recipient of the services.

23 SECTION 23: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 200, of the Municipal Code of  
24 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

25 **6.04.200:** (A) Each person who has a fixed business location outside the City and who,  
26 for hire, operates a truck or fleet of trucks which come into the City to receive

1 merchandise for delivery outside the City or which bring merchandise into the  
2 [city] City and therein make deliveries of such merchandise shall pay a fee of  
3 [twenty-five] thirty-five dollars semiannually for each truck so operated.

4 (B) Trucks engaged in interstate commerce are excepted from this  
5 Section.

6 (C) In addition to the businesses mentioned in [the first] Subsection (A)  
7 of this Section, each person having a fixed business location outside the City and  
8 who regularly comes into the City to perform personal services or make repairs,  
9 or who regularly comes in to the City to receive or pick up personal property upon  
10 which repairs, personal services, or work of any kind is performed for hire outside  
11 the City and then returns such personal property to the owner in the City, shall pay  
12 a license fee of twenty-five dollars for each vehicle used to transport persons into  
13 and out of the City.

14 SECTION 24: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 205, of the Municipal Code of  
15 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

16 **6.04.205:** The license fee for a dentist is [fifty] seventy-five dollars semiannually for each  
17 person issued a license under NRS 631 and conducting a private practice, whether  
18 as a sole practitioner or as a member or employee of a firm, and whether  
19 practicing full time or as a supplement to employment with a Federal, State, or  
20 local government agency.

21 SECTION 25: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 210, of the Municipal Code of  
22 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

23 **6.04.210:** The license fee is [fifty] sixty dollars semiannually for each designer or decorator.

24 SECTION 26: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 220, of the Municipal Code of  
25 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

26 **6.04.220:** The license fee for a draftsman is [fifty] seventy-five dollars semiannually.

1 SECTION 27: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 225, of the Municipal Code of  
2 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 **6.04.225:** The license fee for an employment agency is [fifty] two hundred fifty dollars  
4 semiannually after the applicant has obtained a State license.

5 SECTION 28: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 230, of the Municipal Code of  
6 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

7 **6.04.230:** The license fee for an engineer is [fifty] seventy-five dollars semiannually for each  
8 professional engineer issued a certificate of registration under NRS 625 and  
9 conducting a private practice, whether as a sole practitioner or as a member or  
10 employee of a firm, and whether practicing full time or as a supplement to  
11 employment with a Federal, State, or local government agency.

12 SECTION 29: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 245, of the Municipal Code of  
13 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

14 **6.04.245:** The license fee is [two hundred fifty] four hundred dollars semiannually for each  
15 finance company or branch thereof other than a bank, mortgage company, savings  
16 and loan, credit union, trust company, or pawnbroker who is in the business of  
17 loaning money to others for profit and who holds himself out to the general public  
18 as such. A State license under NRS 675 is also required.

19 SECTION 30: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 260, of the Municipal Code of  
20 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

21 **6.04.260:** The license fee for health care services is [fifty] one hundred dollars semiannually.

22 SECTION 31: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 265, of the Municipal Code of  
23 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

24 **6.04.265:** The license fee is [fifty] one hundred dollars semiannually for health studios or  
25 spas open for business to the general public and not selling memberships. For fees  
26 and regulations of health studios and spas selling memberships, see Chapter 6.54.

1 SECTION 32: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 280, of the Municipal Code of  
2 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 **6.04.280:** The license fee is [fifty] one hundred dollars semiannually for each insurance  
4 adjuster as defined by NRS 684A.020(1) who has been issued a State license  
5 therefor. A salaried employee of an insurer adjusting claims for such employer  
6 shall not be deemed an adjuster for the purposes of this Section.

7 SECTION 33: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 285, of the Municipal Code of  
8 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

9 **6.04.285:** The license fee for an insurance agent is [ten] fifty dollars semiannually.
