

ORDINANCE NO. 1504

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE IV, CHAPTER 6, SECTION 6, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION; ADOPTING AND ESTABLISHING VALUATION SCHEDULE FOR BOTH NON-ELECTRIFIED AND ELECTRIFIED SIGNS AND BILLBOARDS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH. 1504

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title IV, Chapter 6, Section 6 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

4-6-6: PERMIT FEES: Permit fees for the erection, construction, repair, alteration or moving of any sign or billboard shall be paid to the City through the Department of Building and Safety according to the following:

- (A). The fee for any sign less than 25 square feet of displayed surface, regardless of the type and shape of such sign, shall be a minimum five dollars (\$5.00).
- (B). The fee for signs or decorative surfaces and others advertising displays or devices which are not included under any other subsection of this Section shall be based upon their valuation using the permit fee schedule of the Building Code.
- (C). The fee for temporary political signs installed for normal campaign time and within the primary or general election shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per candidate regardless of the number of signs posted.
- (D). Permit fees for signs other than those specified in subsections A, B and C of this Section shall be based upon their valuation. The valuation of a sign for purposes of this Section shall be determined from the following TABLE and permit fee shall be based on permit fee schedule of the Building Code for each separate sign.

"HEIGHT ZONE:

Dimension for classifying height zone A, B or C shall be taken as a distance between the ground elevation and the highest point of displayed surface

A = up to 30' -0"

B = over 30' -0" up to 50' -0"

C = over 50' -0"

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the City jail for not more than six months, or any combination of such fine and/or imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
