

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 1627

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE V, CHAPTER 1, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SECTION DESIGNATED AS SECTION 24 TO PROVIDE THAT ALL ADULT ORIENTED BOOKSTORES AND ADULT ORIENTED THEATRES WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, SHALL BE CLASSIFIED AS PRIVILEGED LICENSE BUSINESSES REQUIRING MORE STRINGENT REGULATION AND INVESTIGATION; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Adult oriented bookstores and adult oriented theatres require substantial police investigation in order to prevent and eliminate any abuse against the public health, safety and morals; and

WHEREAS, the present license structure only provides that adult oriented bookstores and adult oriented theatres are only required to have the ordinary general business license; and

WHEREAS, it would be to the best interests of the public health, safety, and morals of the citizens of the City of Las Vegas that any business licenses issued to adult oriented bookstores and adult oriented movie theatres be classified henceforth as privileged;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title V, Chapter 1, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section designated Section 24, to read as follows:

5-1-24 All adult oriented bookstores and all adult oriented theatres shall be classified as privileged business licenses. All said applications for a privileged business license shall pay a minimum fee of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) as and for an investigation fee for each and every person associated with either the management or the ownership of any adult oriented bookstores and/or adult oriented theatres.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm, or corporation, violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
