

ORDINANCE NO. 1596

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE X, CHAPTER 3, SECTION 6, SUBSECTION (A), OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, TO 1596
MODIFY THE DEFINITION OF A HOLIDAY FOR PURPOSES OF THE OPERATING TIME OF
PARKING METERS; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING
PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF
ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH .

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title X, Chapter 3, Section 6, Subsection (A), of the Municipal
Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as
follows:

10-3-6 PARKING TIME LIMITS:

(A) Parking meters shall be operated in the parking meter zone
every day between the hours of nine o'clock (9:00) A.M. and
six o'clock (6:00) P.M., except Sundays and legal holidays,
and except as hereinafter in subsection (B) 2 expressly provided.

Within the meaning of this Chapter, the term "holiday" shall
include the following days only: January 1, the third Monday
in February, the fourth Monday in May, July 4, the first
Monday in September, the second Monday in October, the
fourth Monday in October, October 31, Thanksgiving Day,
December 25, and any declared general holiday by the President
of the United States, Governor of the State of Nevada, or Mayor
of the City of Las Vegas; provided, however, that by resolution
of the majority of its members, the Board of Commissioners may
extend the time for operation of any parking meters in the parking
meter zone for an additional period of time; provided, the proper
notice for such extended time of operation is placed on each such
parking meter.

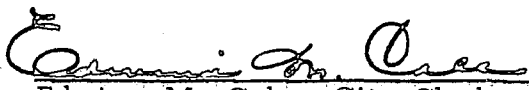
SECTION 2. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions
of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more
than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six months, or
any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall
constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

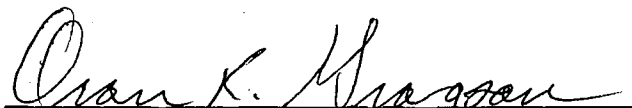

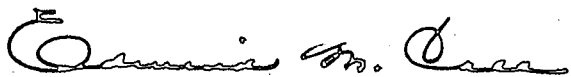

ORDINANCE NO. 1596

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title X, Chapter 3, Section 6, Subsection (A), of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

10-3-6 PARKING TIME LIMITS:
(A) Parking meters shall be operated in the parking meter zone everyday between the hours of nine o'clock (9:00) A.M. and six o'clock (6:00) P.M., except Sundays and legal holidays, and except as hereinafter in subsection (B) 2 expressly provided. Within the meaning of this Chapter, the term "holiday" shall in-

SECTION 2. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
