11 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY
12 ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

13 SECTION 1: Title 6, Chapter 74, Section 130, of the Municipal
14 Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

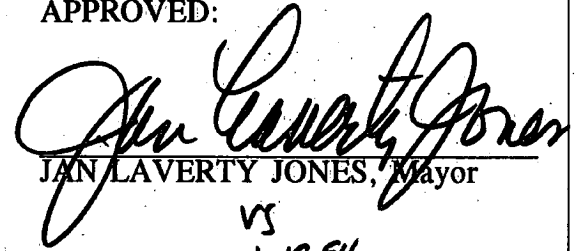
15 6.74.130: Every secondhand dealer must keep without concealment property that is
16 identifiable for a period of [ten] **thirty** days after the receipt thereof has been reported or a record
17 of the receipt of the property is furnished or mailed to the Police Department and before selling,
18 shipping or otherwise disposing of the same. While in the possession of any secondhand dealer,
19 all goods shall remain subject to inspection by the Police Department during normal business
20 hours.

21 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence,
22 clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional
23 or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the
24 validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City
25 Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares that it would have passed each section,
26 subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that
any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases
be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

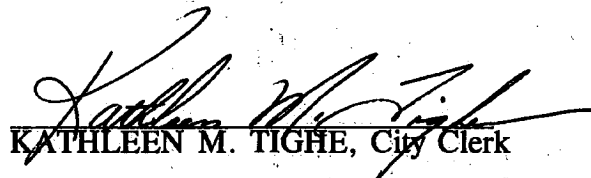
1 SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections,
