AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE LAS VEGAS MUNICIPAL COURT; AMENDING TITLE 2, CHAPTER 26, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, TO EXPAND THE NUMBER OF DEPARTMENTS OF THE LAS VEGAS MUNICIPAL COURT FROM FOUR TO FIVE; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

Summary: Creates Fifth Department
of Las Vegas Municipal Court

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 2, Chapter 26, Section 10, of the
Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is
hereby amended to read as follows:

2.26.010: (A) There shall be a Municipal Court of the City consisting of [~~four~~] five departments. The departments shall be numbered 1 through [~~4,~~] 5, and a duly elected and qualified Judge shall preside over each department.

(B) The Municipal Court shall be held in the facilities provided at Las Vegas City Hall.

SECTION 2: Title 2, Chapter 26, Section 20, of the
Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is
hereby amended to read as follows:

2.26.020: The term of office of Municipal Court Judges shall be for four years; the Judges for Department 1 and Department 4 having been elected at the primary and general elections of May and June, [~~1979;~~] 1987, and the Judges for Department 2, [~~and~~] Department 3 [~~having been~~] and Department 5 will be elected at the primary and general elections of May and June, [~~1977.]~~ 1989.

1 SECTION 3: Title 2, Chapter 26, Section 30, of the Muni-
2 cipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is
3 hereby amended to read as follows:

4 2.26.030 (A) Except as is otherwise provided in Subsections
5 (B) and (C) of this Section and Section 2.26.035,
6 [of this Chapter,] the salary of each Municipal
7 Court Judge shall each be forty-seven thousand five
8 hundred dollars per year.

9 (B) The salaries of the Municipal Court Judges of
10 Departments 1 and 4 shall each be [fifty-five
11 thousand] fifty-seven thousand one hundred forty-
12 five dollars per year. [beginning with the term of
13 office following the primary and general elections
14 that will be held in May and June 1987.]

15 (C) The salaries of the Municipal Court Judges of
16 Departments 2, [and] 3 and 5 shall each be
17 [fifty-five thousand] fifty-seven thousand one
18 hundred fory-five dollars per year beginning with
19 the term of office following the primary and
20 general elections that will be held in May and June
21 of 1989.

22 SECTION 4: Title 2, Chapter 26, Section 35, of the
23 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is
24 hereby amended to read as follows:

25 2.26.035: [(A)] The salaries of the Municipal Court Judges
26 that are provided for in [Subsection (B) of] Section
27 2.26.030 [of this Chapter] shall automatically be
28 increased:

29 [(1)] (A) On the first day of July, [1988,] 1989, in
30 the same proportion that the index figure of the
31 National Consumer Price Index for All Urban Con-
32 sumers for All Items, U.S. City Average (1967 =

1 100) that is published by the Bureau of Labor Sta-
2 tistics, United States Department of Labor, for
3 March of [1988] 1989 has increased above such index
4 figure for March of [1987;] 1988; and

5 [(2)] (B) On the first day of July in each year there-
6 after in the same proportion that such index figure
7 for March of that year has increased above such
8 index figure for March of the previous year.

9 [(B) The salaries of the Municipal Court Judges that are
10 provided for in Subsection C of Section 2.26.030 of
11 this Chapter shall automatically be increased:

12 (1) On the first day of July, 1989, in an amount
13 that is equal to the increase that is provided
14 for in Subsection (A)(1) of this Section and
15 then further increased in the same proportion
16 that the index figure of the National Consumer
17 Price Index for All Urban Consumers for All
18 Items, U.S. City Average (1967 = 100) that is
19 published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics,
20 United States Department of Labor, for March
21 of 1989 has increased above such index figure
22 for March of 1988; and

23 (2) On the first day of July in each year
24 thereafter, in the same proportion that such
25 index figure for March of that year has
26 increased above such index figure for March of
27 the previous year.]

28 SECTION 5: Title 2, Chapter 26, Section 50, of the
29 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is
30 hereby amended to read as follows:

31 2.26.050: (A) There shall be allotted for each of the [four]
32 five departments of the Las Vegas Municipal Court,

a Court Marshal to assist in the operation of the Municipal Court.

(B) The Marshalls shall be hired pursuant to the Rules and Regulations of the Civil Service Board and the Department of Personnel and Employee Relations of the City; provided, however, that the Marshals shall be under the direct supervision of the respective Municipal Court Judge of the Department to which they are assigned.

SECTION 6: If any section, subsection, subdivision paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

SECTION 7: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs






