THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY  
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 2, Chapter 26, Section 10, of the  
Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is  
hereby amended to read as follows:

2.26.010: (A) There shall be a Municipal Court of the City consisting of [five] six departments. The departments shall be numbered 1 through [5] 6, and a duly elected and qualified Judge shall preside over each department.

(B) The Municipal Court shall be held in the facilities provided at Las Vegas City Hall.

SECTION 2: Title 2, Chapter 26, Section 20, of the  
Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is  
hereby amended to read as follows:

2.26.020: The term of office of Municipal Court Judges shall be for four years; the Judges for Department 1, [and] Department 4 and Department 6 [having been] will be elected at the primary and general elections of May and

1 June, [1987] 1991, and the Judges for Department 2,  
2 Department 3 and Department 5 [will be] having been  
3 elected at the primary and general elections of May and  
4 June, 1989.

5 SECTION 3: Title 2, Chapter 26, Section 30, of the  
6 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is  
7 hereby amended to read as follows:

8 2.26.030: (A) Except as is otherwise provided in [Subsections]  
9 Subsection (B) [and (C) ] of this Section and Sec-  
10 tion 2.26.035, the salary of each Municipal Court  
11 Judge shall [each] be [fifty-seven thousand one  
12 hundred forty-five] sixty-nine thousand five  
13 hundred dollars per year[.], to take effect  
14 January 1, 1991.

15 [(B) The salaries of the Municipal Court Judges shall be  
16 sixty-nine thousand five hundred dollars per year,  
17 to take effect January 1, 1991.

18 [(C)] (B) The Municipal Judge who holds seniority in  
19 years of service in office, either elected or  
20 appointed, is the Master Judge. The Master Judge  
21 shall be entitled to a three thousand dollar per  
22 year stipend due to the additional duties imposed  
23 upon him as Master Judge. This stipend shall take  
24 effect as of January 1, 1991.

25 SECTION 4: Title 2, Chapter 26, Section 50, of the  
26 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is  
27 hereby amended to read as follows:

28 2.26.050: (A) There shall be allotted for each of the [five]  
29 six departments of the Las Vegas Municipal Court, a  
30 Court Marshal to assist in the operation of the  
31 Municipal Court.

32 (B) The Marshals shall be hired pursuant to the Rules

1 and Regulations of the Civil Service Board and the  
2 Department of Personnel and Employee Relations of  
3 the City; provided, however, that the Marshals  
4 shall be under the direct supervision of the  
5 respective Municipal Court Judge of the Department  
6 to which they are assigned.

7 SECTION 5: If any section, subsection, subdivision  
8 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any  
9 part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or  
10 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,  
11 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of  
12 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.  
13 The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby  
14 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, sub-  
15 division, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof,  
16 irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsec-  
17 tions, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be  
18 declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

19 SECTION 6: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sec-  
20 tions, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs  
21 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,  
22 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.





Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is  
hereby amended to read as follows:

2.26.020: The term of office of Municipal Court Judges shall be  
for four years; the Judges for Department 1, [and]  
Department 4 and Department 6 [having been] will be  
elected at the primary and general elections of May and  
June, [~~1987~~] 1991, and the Judges for Department 2,  
Department 3 and Department 5 [will be] having been

13 [(C)] (B) The Municipal Judge who holds seniority in  
14 years of service in office, either elected or  
15 appointed, is the Master Judge. The Master Judge  
16 shall be entitled to a three thousand dollar per  
17 year stipend due to the additional duties imposed  
18 upon him as Master Judge. This stipend shall take  
19 effect as of January 1, 1991.

20 SECTION 4: Title 2, Chapter 26, Section 35, of the  
21 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is  
22 hereby amended to read as follows:

23 2.26.035: (A) On the first day of July, 1989, in the same pro-  
24 portion that the index figure of the National Con-  
25 sumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers for All  
26 Items, U.S. City Average (1967 = 100) that is  
27 published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, United  
28 States Department of Labor, for March of 1989 has  
29 increased above such index figure for March of  
30 1988; and

31 (B) On the first day of July in each year thereafter in  
32 the same proportion that such index figure for

1 March of that year has increased above such index  
2 figure for March of the previous year.

3 SECTION 5: Title 2, Chapter 26, Section 50, of the  
4 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is  
5 hereby amended to read as follows:

6 2.26.050: (A) There shall be allotted for each of the [five]  
7 six departments of the Las Vegas Municipal Court, a  
8 Court Marshal to assist in the operation of the  
9 Municipal Court.

10 (B) The Marshals shall be hired pursuant to the Rules  
11 and Regulations of the Civil Service Board and the  
12 Department of Personnel and Employee Relations of  
13 the City; provided, however, that the Marshals  
14 shall be under the direct supervision of the  
15 respective Municipal Court Judge of the Department  
16 to which they are assigned.

17 SECTION 6: If any section, subsection, subdivision  
18 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any  
19 part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or  
20 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,  
21 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of  
22 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.  
23 The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby  
24 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, sub-  
25 division, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof,  
26 irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsec-  
27 tions, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be  
28 declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

29 SECTION 7: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sec-  
30 tions, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
