

ORDINANCE NO. 1744

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE V OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY ADDING THERETO A NEW CHAPTER 37 CONSISTING OF 5 SECTIONS PROVIDING FOR LICENSING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE USE OF SOUND AMPLIFICATION DEVICES; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: TITLE V of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new Chapter 37 consisting of 5 sections as follows:

5-37-1 It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, partnership, corporation, association or business to maintain or operate any loudspeaker or sound amplification device connected with any radio, phonograph, tape recorder, microphone or other device by which sounds are magnified, broadcast, or made heard over any public street or public place without having first secured a license therefor.

5-37-2 Any person, firm, partnership, corporation, association or business desiring a license for the use or operation of such device, shall file an application therefore with the Department of License and Revenue of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, upon a form provided therefore, setting forth the name and address of the applicant, the type of device intended to be used, the date upon which it is intended to be used, and such other information as may be prescribed.

5-37-3 The fee for licenses to be granted under this ordinance shall be twenty-five dollars for each day that said license is in effect. Said licenses shall be issued upon payment of the license fee and shall permit the use of any such device subject to the terms and conditions of this ordinance, only upon the date specified on such license and no others.

5-37-4 No license shall be issued to any person, firm, partnership, corporation, association or business to use any sound amplification device as a means of attracting a crowd for advertising purposes, nor to advertise, cry, hawk, sell or auction any articles, goods, merchandise or services, whatsoever, in such a manner as to attract a crowd or as to cause a public disturbance.

5-37-5 Any violation of any section of this Chapter shall be punishable as a misdemeanor.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses, or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: If any section, paragraph, sentence, phrase, term, word or connotation of this ordinance, or portion thereof is for any reason held invalid, inapplicable or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not invalidate the remaining portions of this ordinance.
