

THIRD AMENDMENT

ORDINANCE NO. 1742

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE X, CHAPTER 3, SECTION 6, SUBSECTION (C), OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY DELETING PARAGRAPH 1 THEREOF, AMENDING PARAGRAPH 2 THEREOF BY MAKING IT PARAGRAPH 1 AND ADDING A NEW PARAGRAPH 2 THEREOF, WHICH SHALL ESTABLISH A NEW RATE STRUCTURE OF PARKING IN THE LAS VEGAS BOULEVARD NORTH AND STEWART LOT AND IN THE MULTIPLE PARKING GARAGES ON CARSON STREET AND OGDEN STREET; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; and REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREOF.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title X, Chapter 3, Section 6, Subsection (C) of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

10-3-6 (C) Parking or standing a vehicle in any of the City owned parking lots shall be at the following rates:

(1. In the Union Pacific North Lot and the Union Pacific South Lot, ten cent (10¢) coin of the United States of America for each one hour, twenty-five cent (25¢) coin of the United States of America for three (3) hours, fifty cent (50¢) coin of the United States of America for six (6) hours and seventy-five cent (75¢) coin of the United States of America for nine (9) hours;)

(2.) 1. In the Fourth and Stewart Lot (located on the West side of Fourth Street between Stewart and Mesquite Streets), five cent (5¢) coin of the United States of America for each one-half hour, ten cent (10¢) coin of the United States of America for each one hour, and twenty-five cent (25¢) coin of the United States of America for each two hours, with a maximum time limit of four hours;

2. In the Las Vegas Blvd. North and Stewart Lot (located on the south side of Stewart between Las Vegas Blvd. North and 4th Street), five cent (5¢) coin of the United States of America for each one-half hour, ten cent (10¢) coin of the United States of America for each one hour, and

twenty-five cent (25¢) coin of the United States of America for each two hours, with a maximum of four hours;

3. Multiple parking garages for vehicles other than motorcycles:

(a) In the multiple parking garage on Carson Street (located on the North side of Carson between Casino Center Boulevard and Third Street):

i. Hourly: twenty-five cents (25¢) per hour; \$1.50 for a ten-hour maximum period.

ii. Monthly: \$18.00 per month.

iii. Clark County Officials/Employees - \$15.00 per month; Block of 130 maximum.

(b) In the multiple parking garage on Ogden Street (located on the South side of Ogden between Third Street and Fourth Street):

i. Hourly: twenty-five cents (25¢) per hour; \$1.50 for a ten-hour maximum period.

ii. Monthly: \$15.00 per month per space; [\$12.50 per month per space when purchased in a block of more than 25 spaces and less than 75 spaces; \$10.00 per month per space when purchased in a block of more than 74 spaces.]

(c) A validation system shall be in effect for all downtown merchants. Those desiring to participate in the validation procedure may rent a valometer for \$3.00 per month. The price shall be as follows:

<u>Number of Validations</u>	<u>Price per Validation</u>
0-999	19¢
1,000-1,999	18¢
2,000 or more	17¢

Said validations are on a usage basis per month. The valometer shall be read at the end of each month, and fees based on the number of validations used shall be paid to the City as per the above rate schedule.

Unlimited validation shall be allowable as follows:

One validation shall represent each hour, and a person in possession of more than one validation shall be allowed an additional hour for each such validation.

(d) Hotels and inns in the downtown area shall be allowed 24-hour parking for room guests, the price thereof to be the sum of [~~\$2.00~~] \$1.00 for every 24-hour period. Also, an 8-hour valometer stamp. 8 hours for \$1.00.

4. In the multiple parking garage on Carson Street (located on the North side of Carson between Casino Center Boulevard and Third Street) and on Ogden Street (located on the South side of Ogden between Third and Fourth Street) for motorcycles, twenty-five cents (25¢) per hour; \$1.50 for a ten-hour maximum period; \$9.00 per month.

5. A validation system for parking at the Ogden Ramp only shall be allowed for all persons called to jury duty with the Eighth Judicial District Court. The price shall be fifty cents (50¢) per validation.


SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation, violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the City jail for not more than six (6) months or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


