ORDINANCE NO. 5662

AN ORDINANCE TO ALLOW MIXED-USE DEVELOPMENTS BY MEANS OF SPECIAL USE PERMIT THROUGHOUT THE NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION AREA ESTABLISHED BY THE LAS VEGAS 2020 MASTER PLAN, AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

Proposed by: Robert S. Genzer, Director of Planning and Development

Summary: Allows mixed-use developments by means of special use permit throughout the Neighborhood Revitalization Area established by the Las Vegas 2020 Master Plan.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 19, Chapter 4, Section 50, Subsection (B), of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended by amending the subdivision entitled "MIXED-USE" to read as follows:

MIXED-USE [R-3, R-4, P-R, N-S, O, C-1 and C-2] (Limited Area)

[(*)] *(1) Within the [Downtown Las Vegas Redevelopment Area, as established by Ordinance No. 3218 and] Neighborhood Revitalization Area, as that area is depicted in the Las Vegas 2020 Master Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 5250, as it may be amended from time to time:

(a) Residential uses permitted as of right in the R-3 and R-4 Zoning Districts may be permitted by means of Special Use Permit within a P-R, N-S, O, C-1, or a C-2 Zoning District; and

(b) Nonresidential uses permitted as of right in the P-R, N-S, O, and C-1 Zoning Districts may be permitted by means of Special Use Permit within an R-3 or R-4 Zoning District.

2. When residential and nonresidential uses are approved for a single parcel:

(a) The nonresidential use shall be located at ground level fronting the primary public right-of-way, and the primary entryway to that use shall be directly from and oriented to a street; and

(b) The overall architecture of the front elevation shall highlight the difference in uses through variations in volume and proportion, and shall be treated as a cohesive whole through finishes and colors.

SECTION 2: In Section 1 of this Ordinance, the brackets that follow the title of the

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subdivision being amended are not intended to indicate deleted matter, but instead are used as the means of indicating the applicable districts.

SECTION 3: For purposes of Section 2.100(3) of the City Charter, LVMC 19.04.050 is deemed to be a subchapter rather than a section.

SECTION 4: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

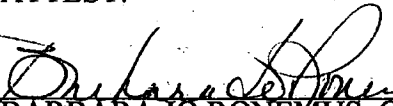
