4 AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO SEWER SERVICE CHARGES; AMENDING TITLE
5 14, CHAPTER 4, SECTIONS 80 AND 90, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE
6 CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, TO PROVIDE THAT THE
7 AMOUNTS OF THE ANNUAL BILLINGS OF SEWER SERVICE CHARGES SHALL BE
8 PAID ANNUALLY OR, AT THE OPTION OF THE SEWER SERVICE CUSTOMER AND
UPON THE PAYMENT OF AN ADDITIONAL \$3.00 PER INSTALLMENT FOR THE
PRIVILEGE OF DOING SO, EITHER SEMI-ANNUALLY OR QUARTERLY; PRO-
VIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO AND REPEALING
ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

12 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY

13 ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

14 SECTION 1: Title 14, Chapter 4, Section 80, of the
15 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is
16 hereby amended to read as follows:

17 14.04.080: All bills for services rendered by or through the
18 municipal sewage disposal system shall be rendered
19 annually in advance on the first day of the month on
20 which the annual cycle billing established for such pre-
21 mises shall commence, shall be payable annually in
22 advance or, if the customer elects to pay the amount of
23 any annual bill in semi-annual or quarterly install-
24 ments, upon notification to the Director of Business
25 Activity within thirty days after the due date specified
26 in such bill of that election and the payment of the
27 first semi-annual or quarterly installment plus a charge
28 in the amount of [five] three dollars per deferred
29 installment for the privilegte of doing so, semi-
30 annually or quarterly in advance and shall constitute a
31 lien against the premises. Payment of all bills ren-
32 dered shall be made to the Department of Business Acti-

1 vity, and no license shall be granted for the conducting
2 of any business requiring a license in any multiple
3 dwelling or place of business unless the remaining por-
4 tion of the current year's annual billing, [of,] or, if
5 the customer has elected to pay in semi-annual install-
6 ments[,] or quarterly, the remaining portion of the
7 current semi-annual or quarterly installment thereof, as
8 the case may be, shall be paid in advance.

9 SECTION 2: Title 14, Chapter 4, Section 90, of the
10 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is
11 hereby amended to read as follows:

12 14.04.090: The full amount of the sewer service bill shall be
13 paid by each sewer service customer within thirty days
14 after the due date specified in such customer's bill;
15 provided, however, that, if the customer has elected to
16 pay the amount of such bill in: [semi-annual]

17 (A) Semi-annual installments, as is provided for in
18 LVMC 14.04.080, the first such semi-annual
19 installment shall be paid within thirty days after
20 such due date, and the second shall be paid within
21 two hundred ten days after such due date[.]; or

22 (B) Quarterly installments, as provided for in LVMC
23 14.04.080, the first quarterly installment shall be
24 paid within thirty days after such due date, the
25 second shall be paid within one hundred twenty days
26 after such due date, the third shall be paid within
27 two hundred ten days after such due date, and the
28 fourth shall be paid within three hundred days
29 after such due date.

30 If any portion of the sewer service bill, or, if the
31 customer has elected to pay such bill in semi-annual or
32 quarterly installments, any portion of either or any of

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such semi-annual or quarterly installments, as the case may be, remains unpaid for thirty days or more following the date on which the same was due, the amount outstanding shall be deemed delinquent and a ten percent penalty shall be charged thereon. If the amount outstanding and the penalty assessed thereon remain unpaid for sixty days or more following the date on which the same was due, sewer service to such customer may be discontinued, with the cost of disconnection and reconnection to be borne by the sewer service customer or by the owner of the property which received the sewer service or by both the sewer service customer and the owner of the property which received the sewer service.

SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.


SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs

2 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


