13 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY
14 ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

15 SECTION 1: Title 6, Chapter 50, Section 310, of the
16 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is
17 hereby amended as follows:

18 6.50.310: No tavern license shall be located within one thousand
19 five hundred feet of any other tavern or comparable
20 license[.] either within or without the corporate bound-
21 aries of the City. The distance between the establish-
22 ments shall be measured in a straight line from the pri-
23 mary public entrance of the proposed establishment to
24 the primary public entrance of any existing licensed
25 premises, disregarding all intervening obstacles. At
26 the request of the applicant, the City Council, in its
27 discretion, may waive this provision based on a con-
28 sideration of the nature and character of the surround-
29 ing neighborhood. Notice of the time and place of the
30 City Council's consideration of the request for waiver
31 shall be given by a published announcement in a news-
32 paper of general circulation in the City not less than

1 five days or more than ten days prior to the date of
2 the hearing. Licensed premises which are included in
3 the classifications listed in this Section and which
4 held valid licenses therefor on November 1, 1980, are
5 exempt from the provisions of this Section only as long
6 as they continue to hold valid licenses. This Section
7 does not apply to an establishment which has a non-
8 restricted gaming license in connection with a hotel
9 having one hundred or more guestrooms.


10 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision
11 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any
12 part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or
13 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,
14 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of
15 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.
16 The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby
17 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, sub-
18 division, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof,
19 irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsec-
20 tions, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be
21 declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.


