AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO LIQUOR CONTROL; AMENDING TITLE 6, CHAPTER 50, SECTION 440, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, TO PROVIDE THAT THE RESPONSIBLE LICENSEE, BUT ONLY THE RESPONSIBLE LICENSEE, OF A SPECIAL EVENT MUST SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE THE REQUIRED ALCOHOL AWARENESS TRAINING OR, IN LIEU THEREOF, AN ALCOHOL AWARENESS CERTIFICATION EXAMINATION; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 6, Chapter 50, Section 440, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

6.50.440: (A) [As of April 1, 1988,] Except as is otherwise provided in subsection (B), no person may be employed by a licensee to serve, sell or distribute alcoholic beverages [for consumption on the licensed premises as a bartender, except as a bartender trainee, or for consumption off the licensed premises as a retail sales clerk] unless such person has successfully completed[, or, with respect to a bartender trainee, within thirty days after he is so employed, either an alcohol awareness certification examination administered by the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department or] a compre-

1           hensive alcohol awareness training course of not  
2           less than four hours in duration. Such a course  
3           must include a final test that determines whether  
4           the course participant has successfully completed  
5           the course.

6           (B) [As of April 1, 1989, no person may be employed by  
7           a licensee to serve, sell or distribute alcoholic  
8           beverages in any capacity unless such person has  
9           successfully completed either the examination or  
10          the training course described above. This require-  
11          ment] With respect to a special event that is  
12          licensed pursuant to LVMC 6.50.120 or 6.50.130,  
13          only the responsible licensee thereof needs suc-  
14          cessfully to complete such alcohol awareness  
15          training course, or such licensee may, in lieu  
16          thereof, substitute a successfully completed alco-  
17          hol awareness certification examination that is  
18          administered by the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police  
19          Department. The requirement of successfully  
20          completing such examination or training course  
21          shall not apply to holders of wholesale general  
22          licenses.

23          (C) Persons who successfully complete either the exami-  
24          nation or the training course described above shall  
25          be deemed to be certified for alcohol awareness.

26          SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall not invalidate any suc-  
27          cessfully completed alcohol awareness certification examination  
28          that was administered by the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police  
29          Department prior to April 5, 1989.

30          SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision  
31          paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any  
32          part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or

1 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,  
2 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of  
3 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.  
4 The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby  
5 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, sub-  
6 division, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof,  
7 irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsec-  
8 tions, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be  
9 declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

10 SECTION 4: Whenever in this ordinance any act is prohi-  
11 bited or is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a  
12 misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act  
13 is required or the failure to do any act is made or declared to  
14 be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, the doing of any such  
15 prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall  
16 constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be  
17 punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment  
18 for a term of not more than six months, or by any combination of  
19 such fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation of this  
20 ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

21 SECTION 5: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sec-  
22 tions, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs  
23 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,  
24 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.



THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 6, Chapter 50, Section 440, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

6.50.440: (A) [As of April 1, 1988,] Except as is otherwise provided in subsection (B), no person may be employed by a licensee to serve, sell or distribute alcoholic beverages [for consumption on the licensed premises as a bartender, except as a bartender trainee, or for consumption off the licensed premises as a retail sales clerk] unless such person has successfully completed[, or, with respect to a bartender trainee, within thirty days after he is so employed,] either an alcohol awareness certification examination administered by the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department or a comprehensive alcohol awareness training course of not less than four hours in duration. Such a course must include a final test that determines whether the course participant has successfully completed

1 the course.

2 (B) [As of April 1, 1989, no person may be employed by  
3 a licensee to serve, sell or distribute alcoholic  
4 beverages in any capacity unless such person has  
5 successfully completed either the examination or  
6 the training course described above. This require-  
7 ment] With respect to a special event that is  
8 licensed pursuant to LVMC 6.50.120 or 6.50.130,  
9 only the responsible licensee thereof needs suc-  
10 cessfully to complete such alcohol awareness cer-  
11 tification examination or alcohol awareness

19 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision  
20 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any  
21 part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or  
22 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,  
23 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of  
24 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.  
25 The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby  
26 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, sub-  
27 division, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof,

31 SECTION 3: Whenever in this ordinance any act is prohi-  
32 bited or is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a

1 misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act  
2 is required or the failure to do any act is made or declared to  
3 be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, the doing of any such  
4 prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall  
5 constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be  
6 punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment  
7 for a term of not more than six months, or by any combination of  
8 such fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation of this  
9 ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

10 SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sec-  
11 tions, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs  
12 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,  
13 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
