SECTION 1: Title 2, Chapter 26, Section 30, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.26.030: (A) Except as is otherwise provided in Subsections (B) and (C) of this Section and Section 2.26.035, the salary of each Municipal Court Judge shall each be [forty-seven thousand five hundred] fifty-seven thousand one hundred forty-five dollars per year.

(B) The salaries of the Municipal Court Judges [of Departments 1 and 4] shall [each] be [fifty-seven thousand one hundred forty-five] sixty-nine thousand five hundred dollars per year[.], to take effect January 1, 1991.

(C) [The salaries of the Municipal Court Judges of Departments 2, 3 and 5 shall each be fifty-seven thousand one hundred forty-five dollars per year beginning with the term of office following the

1 primary and general elections of May and June,
2 1989.] The Municipal Judge who holds seniority in
3 years of service in office, either elected or
4 appointed, is the Master Judge. The Master Judge
5 shall be entitled to a three thousand dollar per
6 year stipend due to the additional duties imposed
7 upon him as Master Judge. This stipend shall take
8 effect as of January 1, 1991.

9 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision


