

ORDINANCE NO. 811

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DEALING WITH LICENSING FOR THE PURPOSES OF REGULATION AND REVENUE OF EVERY KIND OF LAWFUL BUSINESS TRANSACTED OR CARRIED ON WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, STATE OF NEVADA; AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 715 AND ADDING THERETO A NEW SECTION HEREBY DESIGNATED AS SECTION 10(a); PROVIDING FOR THE TRANSFER OF A BUSINESS LICENSE TO A NEW LOCATION AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas deems it advisable and for the best welfare of licensees and for the citizens of the City of Las Vegas that regulation concerning removal of business location of licenses is necessary to the best interest of the citizens; and

WHEREAS, certain inspection charges are incurred by the City in a removal of a business licensee's address; and

WHEREAS, said inspection charges should be sustained by the licensee under the regulatory powers of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 10 of Ordinance No. 715 is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section hereby designated as Section 10(a):

SECTION 10(a). NEW LOCATION DESIRE. A licensee shall have the right to change the location of the licensed business provided he shall:

(1) APPROVAL OF LICENSE OFFICER. Obtain permission from the Superintendent of License by filing the necessary application, which form will be provided by the Superintendent of Licenses, approval to be granted by the issuance of a new license.

(2) PAYMENT OF FEE. Payment of regulatory fee of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars to the License Department of the City of Las Vegas upon filing of said application.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or six (6) months in jail, or by a combination of both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect as in the next section provided, and final passage.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk and Clerk of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas shall cause this ordinance to be published once a week for two successive weeks immediately following its first reading and adoption in the Las Vegas Sun, a daily newspaper published in the City of Las Vegas.
