

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE VI, CHAPTER 5, SECTIONS 3, 5 AND 7 PROVIDING FOR REGISTRATION OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES; PROVIDING FOR THE COST OF SUCH REGISTRATION; PROVIDING FOR REGULATIONS THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO AND REPEALING SUB SECTION D OF CHAPTER 5, TITLE III AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES, PARTS OF ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960, IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas to ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Title VI, Chapter 5, Section 3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

COMPLIANCE REQUIRED: It shall be unlawful for any person to accept employment in any gambling house or as a driver or operator of any taxi cab or in any establishment where alcoholic beverages as defined in this Chapter are sold at retail and consumed on the premises unless such person shall have first registered his name and address with the Police Department and shall have had his thumbprints, fingerprints and photograph taken and filed with the Bureau of Identification of the City and have received a certificate showing compliance therewith.

Every person seeking to be registered under the provisions of this Chapter shall first pay to the City the sum of three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50) as a condition precedent to having issued to him or her the certificate provided in Section 6-5-4.

Every person registered pursuant to the provisions of this Chapter seeking a replacement or reissuance of a certificate previously issued to him or her shall pay the City the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) for such replaced or reissued certificate.

SECTION 2. Title VI, Chapter 5, Section 5 is hereby amended to read as follows:

(A) Upon such employee complying with the provisions of this Chapter and after the Chief of Police shall receive the information provided in Section 6-5-4 the Chief shall issue a certificate valid for three (3) years from the date of issuance, showing compliance therewith and immediately invalidate the temporary certificate issued; provided, however that the Chief shall have power and authority to refuse a certificate to any person who has been convicted of a felony, if in his opinion, such person is not a fit and proper person to have such certificate.

(B) Upon the expiration of such certificate, each employee required to be registered under the terms of this Chapter shall have reissued to him or her a new certificate valid for three (3) years, upon payment of a fee of three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50). Upon the expiration of a three (3) year certificate each employee registered hereunder shall apply for a new three (3) year certificate which shall be reissued at a cost of three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50). Every person so registered shall apply for a new card within thirty (30) days prior to the expiration of such card.

(C) When the Chief of Police shall have issued any certificate to any individual as a gambling house employee, employee of an establishment where alcoholic beverages are sold, or taxi driver, the same may be revoked at any time thereafter by the Chief if it shall appear that such individual has been convicted of a felony, or has been convicted of two (2) or more misdemeanors involving moral turpitude.

(D) The Chief of Police shall make available to each employing establishment within the City a postcard with the following information typed thereon and it shall be the duty of the payroll clerk of each establishment to fill in the information on said card and mail it to the Chief of Police at Post Office Box 1432, Las Vegas, Nevada, within a period of five (5) days from the date said registered employee becomes employed within said establishment:

(E) Every person licensed under the provisions of this Chapter shall have in his possession at all times while working the certificate provided for herein.

SECTION 3. Title VI, Chapter 5, Section 7 is hereby amended to read as follows:

TERM OF CERTIFICATE: Every person heretofore registered as required by this Chapter shall, secure a reissuance of the certificate hereto issued upon the expiration, or within thirty (30) days prior to expiration of the present certificate.

SECTION 4. Subsection D of Chapter 5, Title III is hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, chapters, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

ORDINANCE NO. 892

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE VI, CHAPTER 5, SECTIONS 3, 5 AND 7 PROVIDING FOR REGISTRATION OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES; PROVIDING FOR THE COST OF SUCH REGISTRATION; PROVIDING FOR REGULATIONS THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO AND REPEALING SUB SECTION D OF CHAPTER 5, TITLE III AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES, PARTS OF ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960, IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas to ordain as follows: SECTION 1. Title VI, Chapter 5, Section 3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

COMPLIANCE REQUIRED: It shall be unlawful for any person to accept employment in any gambling house or as a driver or operator of any taxi, cab or in any establishment where alcoholic beverages as defined in this Chapter are sold at retail and consumed, unless the person has first registered his name and address with the Police Department, shall have his photograph taken, fingerprints and photograph taken and filed with the Bureau of Identification of the City and have received a certificate showing compliance therewith.

Every person seeking to be registered under the provisions of this Chapter shall first pay to the City the sum of three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50) as a condition precedent, to having issued to him or her, the certificate provided in Section 6-3-4.

Every person registered pursuant to the provisions of this Chapter seeking a replacement or reissuance of a certificate previously issued to him or her shall pay the City the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) for such replacement or reissued certificate.

SECTION 2. Title VI, Chapter 5, Section 5 is hereby amended to read as follows:

(A) Upon such employee complying with the provisions of this Chapter and after the Chief of Police shall receive the information provided in Section 6-5-4 the Chief shall issue a certificate valid for three (3) years from the date of issuance, showing compliance therewith and immediately invalidate the temporary certificate issued; provided, however that the Chief shall have power and authority to refuse a certificate to any person who has been convicted of a felony, if in his opinion, such person is not a fit and proper person to have such certificate.

(B) Upon the expiration of such certificate, each employee required to be registered under the terms of this Chapter shall have reissued to him or her a new certificate valid for three (3) years, upon payment of a fee of three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50). Upon the expiration of a three (3) year certificate each employee registered hereunder shall apply for a new three (3) year certificate which shall be reissued at a cost of three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50). Every person so registered shall apply for a new card within thirty (30) days prior to the expiration of such card.

(C) When the Chief of Police shall have issued any certificate to any individual as a gambling house employee, employee of an establishment where alcoholic beverages are sold, or taxi driver, the same may be revoked at any time thereafter by the Chief if it shall appear that such individual has been convicted of a felony, or has been convicted of two (2) or more misdemeanors involving moral turpitude.

(D) The Chief of Police shall make available to each employing establishment within the City a postcard with the following information typed thereon and it shall be the duty of the payroll clerk of each establishment to fill in the information on said card and mail it, to the Chief of Police at Post Office Box 1432, Las Vegas, Nevada, within a period of five (5) days from the date said registered employee becomes employed within said establishment.

(E) Every person licensed under the provisions of this Chapter shall have in his possession at all times while working the certificate provided for herein.

SECTION 3. Title VI, Chapter 5, Section 7 is hereby amended to read as follows:

TERM OF CERTIFICATE: Every person heretofore registered as required by this Chapter shall, secure a reissuance of the certificate hereto issued upon the expiration, or within thirty (30) days prior to expiration of the present certificate.

SECTION 4. Subsection D of Chapter 5, Title III is hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, chapter, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
