

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE X, CHAPTER 2, SECTION 10 BY PROVIDING RESTRICTIONS FOR PASSENGERS IN VEHICLES FOR HIRE AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES, PARTS OF ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960, IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND FOR PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF.

SECTION 1. Section 10 of Chapter 2 of Title X is hereby amended to read as follows:

RESTRICTIONS ON AND FOR PASSENGERS: It shall be unlawful for any licensee, operator or chauffeur under the provisions of this chapter to permit passengers to ride on the running boards, or sit upon the outside of his vehicle while the same is in motion, or to permit more than six (6) passengers, including the driver, to ride in a taxicab at any one time.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.
