

ORDINANCE NO. 862

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE V, CHAPTER 18, SECTION 8, SUBSECTION (G), OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960; BY EXTENDING THE TAVERN ZONE BOUNDARIES; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 8, Subsection (G), of Chapter 18, Title V of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960, is hereby amended to read as follows:


- (G) Taverns may be maintained only in that portion of the City bounded by Main Street on the west, Ogden Street on the north, 2nd Street on the east, Carson Street on the south; and on Fremont Street between 8th Street and San Francisco Avenue; and on each side of Las Vegas Boulevard, both North and South, except on either side between Foremaster Lane and Bonanza Road; and on each side of Main Street, both North and South; and on Jackson Street from one hundred (100') feet east of "D" Street to one hundred feet (100') west of "F" Street; and on "D" Street from Monroe to Van Buren; and on each side of Charleston Boulevard, commencing at the intersection of East Charleston and Fremont Street and extending westerly along Charleston Boulevard to 10th Street; and on each side of West Bonanza Road commencing at Main Street and extending to Highland Drive; on West Charleston from the intersection of Valley View Boulevard west to the city limits and on San Francisco Avenue both east and west. Tavern areas herein designated are subject, however, to the proper zoning on each street mentioned.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, chapters, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00, or by imprisonment in the City Jail for not more than six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Tavern areas herein designated are subject, however, to the proper zoning on each street mentioned.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, chapters, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
