

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE I, CHAPTER 18, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960, BY AMENDING THE CIVIL SERVICE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, COUNTY OF CLARK, STATE OF NEVADA; FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF SAID CITY; DEFINING TERMS; PROVIDING FOR EXAMINATIONS; ESTABLISHING ELIGIBILITY LISTS; PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENTS; PROMOTIONS; DISCIPLINARY ACTION; REPORTS AND RECORDS; CLASSIFICATION AND PAY PLANS; AND ALL MATTERS RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. That a certain document, three (3) copies of which are on file in the Office of the City Clerk, of the City of Las Vegas, being marked and designated as Civil Service Rules and Regulations, be, and the same are hereby referred to and adopted as the Civil Service Rules and Regulations of the City of Las Vegas, and by said reference and adoption, made a part of this ordinance, the same as if it was fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, but it is specifically provided that neither this ordinance nor any repeal hereby provided shall in any way affect in any way the prosecution for the violation of any ordinance heretofore passed, pending at the time of the adoption of this ordinance.
