

ORDINANCE NO. 857

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR FEES AND CHARGES FOR SERVICES TO BE FURNISHED OR RENDERED BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC; PROVIDING FOR REGULATIONS THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. POLICE DEPARTMENT, SCHEDULE OF FEES: There is hereby established a schedule of fees which shall be charged for services rendered or furnished by the Police Department of the City of Las Vegas as follows:

- (A) The fees which shall be charged for services rendered or furnished by the Police Department and its employees shall be as set forth in Paragraph (C) below.
- (B) These fees shall be charged to all persons and businesses, except those specifically exempted by ordinance.
- (C) SCHEDULE OF FEES:

1. TRAFFIC SERVICES

- a) Motorcycle funeral escorts \$15.00 per man hr.
- b) Motorcycle escorts for house-moving on City streets \$15.00 per man hr.
- c) Special traffic control necessitated by private construction activity \$15.00 per man hr.
- d) Reproduction of traffic reports \$ 1.00 for first three pages
\$.25 each additional page

2. RECORDS SERVICES

- a) Simple Name Check \$.25 each
- b) Full Record Check \$2.00 each

3. IDENTIFICATION SERVICES

- a) Processing fingerprint cards \$2.00 each
- b) Reproduction of reports \$1.00 first page
\$.25 each additional page
- c) Printing photographs \$3.00 each
- d) Preparation of work cards (first card and three year card) or registration.
 - 1) Taxicab driver, commercial nursery employee, shill, change girl, food and cocktail waiter and waitress, porter, busboy, and other employees of gambling establishments or establishments where alcoholic beverages are sold \$3.00

EXCEPT

- ii) Dealers, box men, and pit bosses \$ 5.00
- iii) Reissue and card replacement \$ 1.50

4. SPECIAL SERVICES

- a) Assignments to athletic events, dances, etc.
 - 1) Patrolman \$4.00 per man hour
 - 2) Supervisor \$5.00 per man hour
- b) Any special service undertaken but not specifically provided for herein shall be assessed at a rate not to exceed \$15.00 per man hour and approved by the City Manager.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

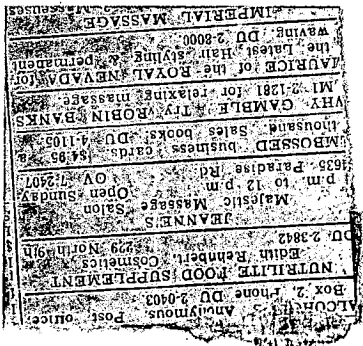
