

ORDINANCE NO. 1040

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE VI, CHAPTER 8, SECTION 2 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960, BY MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY MINOR UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS TO FREQUENT POOL HALLS OR BILLIARD ROOMS IN THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title VI, Chapter 8, Section 2 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960, is hereby amended to read as follows:

PROPRIETORS RESPONSIBLE FOR EXCLUSION OF MINORS: Any proprietor, keeper, bartender, clerk or any other person having charge or control of any saloon, barroom, billiard room or pool room, cigar store or other public place within the City who permits any minor under the age of eighteen (18) years to play, engage in or be present at any game of billiards, pool or cards, is guilty of a misdemeanor. Any minor under the age of eighteen (18) years who plays, engages in or is present at any game of billiards, pool or cards in any public place within the City, is likewise guilty of a misdemeanor. Upon complaint and proof that any proprietor, keeper or person in charge of any of the places mentioned in this Section repeatedly violates this Section of the Code, the license for such place of business may be revoked by the Board of Commissioners.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the City Jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of

the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title VI, Chapter 8, Section 2 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960, is hereby amended to read as follows:

PROPRIETORS RESPONSIBLE FOR EXCLUSION OF MINORS: Any proprietor, keeper, bartender, clerk or any other person having charge or control of any saloon, barroom, billiard room or pool room, cafe, store or other public place within the City who permits any minor under the age of eighteen (18) years to play, engage in or be present at any game of billiards, pool or cards, is guilty of a misdemeanor. Any minor under the age of eighteen (18) years who plays, engages in or is present at any game of billiards, pool or cards in any public place within the City, is likewise guilty of a misdemeanor. Upon complaint and proof that any proprietor, keeper or person in charge of any of the places mentioned in this Section repeatedly violates this Section of the Code, the license for such place of business may be revoked by the Board of Commissioners.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the City Jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


