

ORDINANCE NO. 1039

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE IX, CHAPTER 12, SECTION 1 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960; BY PROVIDING FOR COIN OPERATED NEWSPAPER VENDING MACHINES IN CERTAIN AREAS OF THE CITY UPON BEING GRANTED A PERMIT THEREFOR FROM THE SUPERVISOR OF LICENSE AND REVENUE; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title IX, Chapter 12, Section 1 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960, is hereby amended to read as follows:

OBSTRUCTIONS ON STREETS AND SIDEWALKS: It shall be unlawful for any person to occupy any part or portion of any street, alley, sidewalk, sidewalk space, court, public park or grounds within the City for the purpose of keeping or maintaining any newspaper stand, drinking stand, popcorn stand, weighing machine, automatic vending machine, sandwich wagon or any stand for the sale of notions or any other article of goods, wares, or merchandise, or any similar obstructions, except that newspaper vending machines no larger in size than twenty inches (20") in width, twelve inches (12") in depth, and forty-five inches (45") in over-all height, including stand, may be maintained on the sidewalk areas of Ogden Street, Fremont Street and Carson Street between Main Street and Eighth Street, and on First Street, Second Street, Third Street, Fourth Street and Las Vegas Boulevard between Ogden and Carson Streets upon the obtaining of a permit from the Supervisor of License and Revenue, who shall be vested with discretion in the number of said vending machines to be permitted, and except that oil and gas vending tanks and equipment may be maintained on the curb line on Main Street in the City.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished

by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the City Jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

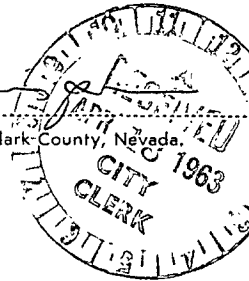
