

ORDINANCE NO. 1570

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE V, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY AMENDING SUBSECTION (A), (B), (C), (D), AND (E) THEREOF TO PROVIDE FOR THREE CLASSES OF COIN-OPERATED AMUSEMENT DEVICES; TO PROVIDE CHANGE IN AGE REQUIREMENTS; AND TO PROVIDE A NEW SUBSECTION TO PROVIDE A DEFINITION OF COIN-OPERATED AMUSEMENT DEVICES; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title V, Chapter 1, Section 22, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

5-1-22: MINORS: RESTRICTIONS:

(A) No license for coin operated amusement devices or machines, as defined in this Chapter shall be issued to any establishment located within five hundred feet (500') of a public or private school or church.

(B) For purposes of this section, a coin operated amusement device or machine means any mechanical, electrical, or other device or contrivance or machine which upon insertion of a coin, token, or similar object therein is available to play or operate. There shall be three classes of coin operated amusement devices or machines for purposes of this section:

- (1) A Class 1 machine or coin operated amusement device shall, upon a play or operation, deliver or entitle the person playing or operating the machine to only the one play or operation which he received by depositing his coin, token or similar object.
- (2) A Class 2 machine or coin operated amusement device shall, upon a play or operation, deliver or entitle the person playing or operating the machine to the privilege of playing or operating the machine only once again without depositing an additional coin, token or similar object.
- (3) A Class 3 machine or coin operated amusement device shall, upon a play or operation, deliver or entitle the person playing or operating the machine to the privilege of only playing or operating the machine again.

There shall be no age restriction on the playing or operating of a Class 1 or Class 2 machine or device.

(C) No person under the age of sixteen (16) years shall be permitted to play a Class 3 coin operated amusement device or machine and any licensee

who shall permit any person under the age of sixteen (16) years to play said device or machine held under such licensee shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

(D) Any person under the age of sixteen (16) years playing a Class 3 coin operated amusement device or machine shall constitute prima facie evidence of the fact that such machine is played with the permission, knowledge and consent of the holder of the license therefor.

(E) The playing of a Class 3 coin operated amusement device or machine by any person under the age of sixteen (16) years shall constitute sufficient grounds for the immediate revocation of the license issued to any person for the said device or machine so played and all other licenses for similar types of machines of whatever class held by such operator.


(F) Any license heretofore issued for the operation of coin operated amusement devices or machines may be revoked without notice if such license is issued to a place of business within five hundred feet (500') of any school or church.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.


