

ORDINANCE NO. 1561

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE XI, CHAPTER 1, SECTIONS 3, 8, 8.5, 9, 10, 11, 20, 21, 22, AND 23 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, 1960 EDITION, TO PROVIDE A DEFINITION FOR CEMETERIES AND TO PROVIDE FOR CEMETERIES SUBJECT TO CERTAIN CONDITIONS IN THE VARIOUS ZONES THROUGHOUT THE CITY; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title XI, Chapter 1, Section 3, Subsection (B) is hereby amended by adding to Paragraph C thereof the following definition:

11-1-3 (A) C Cemetery: A burial ground for deceased humans.

SECTION 2. Section 8, Subsection (A), Paragraph 7 of said title and chapter of said Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subparagraph to be designated subparagraph (f) to read as follows:

11-1-8 (A) 7. (f) Cemeteries as defined herein, provided the cemetery meets the following minimum standards and criteria.

- (1) No upright headstones, crypts, mausoleums or other structures except decorative statuary or similar structures.
- (2) Storage, maintenance and office buildings where elevations are duly approved by the Board of Zoning Adjustment as being compatible with the areas abutting the cemetery.
- (3) Concrete block wall six feet (6') in height surrounding the cemetery except for the primary street frontage area where a front yard equivalent in depth to the yards abutting either side and having the same street frontage will be required, and in the case where there will be a front yard, said six foot (6') block wall shall be setback of the front yard line. The front yard area shall not be used for interment and shall be landscaped.
- (4) Cemeteries shall have major street frontage or the entrance shall be situated within one quarter (1/4) mile of a major street.

(5) Landscaping approved by the Board of Zoning
Adjustment.

SECTION 3. Section 8.5, Subsection (A), Paragraph 7 of said title and chapter is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subparagraph to be designated subparagraph (e) to read as follows:

11-1-8.5 (A) 7. (e) Cemeteries as provided for in Section 8, (A), 7, (f).

SECTION 4. Section 9, Subsection (A), Paragraph 7 of said title and chapter is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subparagraph to be designated subparagraph (e) to read as follows:

11-1-9 (A) 7. (e) Cemeteries as provided for in Section 8, (A), 7, (f).

SECTION 5. Section 10, Subsection (A), Paragraph 5 of said title and chapter is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subparagraph to be designated subparagraph (e) to read as follows:

11-1-10 (A) 5. (e) Cemeteries as provided for in Section 8, (A), 7, (f).

SECTION 6. Section 11, Subsection (A), Paragraph 5 of said title and chapter is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subparagraph to be designated subparagraph (f) to read as follows:

11-1-11 (A) 5. (f) Cemeteries as provided for in Section 8, (A), 7, (f).

SECTION 7. Section 20, Subsection (A), Paragraph 9 of said title and chapter is hereby amended to read as follows:

11-1-20 (A) 9. Mortuaries and mausoleums which may include cemeteries when the cemeteries are developed in conjunction with a mortuary and/or a mausoleum.

SECTION 8. Section 20, Subsection (A), Paragraph 11 of said title and chapter is hereby amended by adding a new subparagraph thereto to be designated subparagraph (h) to read as follows:

11-1-20 (A) 11. (h) Cemeteries as provided for in Section 8, (A), 7, (f).

SECTION 9. Section 21, Subsection (A), of said title and chapter is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph to be designated Paragraph 9 to read as follows:

11-1-21 (A) 9. The following uses subject to the securing of a Use Permit in...

each case, as provided in Section 24 of this Chapter:

(a) Cemeteries as provided for in Section 8, (A), 7, (f)

SECTION 10. Section 22, Subsection (C) of said title and chapter is hereby amended by adding thereto a new Paragraph to be designated Paragraph 4 to read as follows:

11-1-22 (C) 4. Cemeteries as provided for in Section 8, (A), 7, (f).

SECTION 11. Section 23, Subsection (B) of said title and chapter is hereby amended by adding thereto a new Paragraph to be designated Paragraph 4 to read as follows:

11-1-23 (B) 4. The following uses subject to the securing of a Use Permit in each case, as provided in Section 24 of this Chapter:

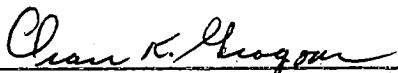
(a) Cemeteries as provided for in Section 8, (A), 7, (f).

SECTION 12. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 13. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.
