

ORDINANCE NO. 1694

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE IV, CHAPTER 10, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, 1960 EDITION, BY DELETING CERTAIN WORDS PERTAINING TO DEAD LOCKING LATCHES FROM SECTION 1(C) (1) (a), SECTION 1(D) (4) (a), SECTION 2(A) (1) (b), SECTION 2(A) (2) (c) and SECTION 4(b); PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title IV, Chapter 10, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1960 Edition is hereby amended by deleting certain words pertaining to dead locking latches within the following designated Sections which are to read as follows:

4-10-1(C) (1) (a):

(C) All front doors of any building or premises shall comply with the following requirements:

1. Tempered glass doors, wood or metal doors with tempered glass panel, solid wood or metal doors shall be secured as follows:

a. A single door shall be equipped with either double cylinder dead bolt that unlocks from both the outside and inside by key, or with cylinder dead bolt that unlocks from outside by key and inside by turnpiece, handle, or knob [, or with dead locking latch having guarded bolt that unlocks from the outside by key and inside by turnpiece, handle or knob].

4-10-1(D) (4) (a):

4: Locking Devices:

a. A single door shall be equipped with either double cylinder dead lock that unlocks from both the outside and inside by key, with cylinder dead lock that unlocks from the outside by key and inside by turnpiece handle, or knob, [with dead locking latch having guarded bolt that unlocks from outside by key and inside by turnpiece, handle, or knob,] or with approved slide bar bolt, crossbar

and/or padlock. If padlock is used, it shall be of hardened steel shackle, with minimum four pin tumbler operation.

4-10-2(A) (1) (b)

b. Dead bolts [or dead locking latches] operable without key from the inside shall be provided on all housing unit entrance doors.

4-10-2(A) (2) (c):

c. Every entrance door to an individual housing unit shall have a dead bolt [or a dead locking latch]. The lock shall be so constructed that [both] the dead bolt [and dead locking latch] may be opened from inside without use of a key. In hotels and other multi-unit buildings having transient occupancies every entrance door to an individual unit shall also be provided with a chain door guard or barrell bolt on the inside.

4-10-4(B):

[(B) A dead locking latch shall be so constructed as to have a minimum throw of one-half inch (1/2").]

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 3. If any section, paragraph, sentence, phrase, term, word or connotation of this ordinance, or portion thereof, is for any reason held invalid, inapplicable, or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not invalidate the remaining portions of this ordinance.



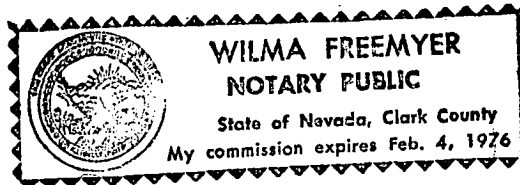

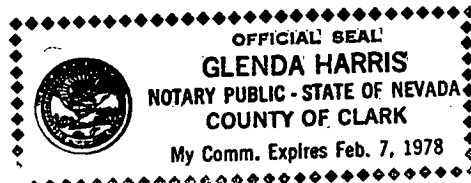
