

ORDINANCE No. 1838

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE XI CHAPTER 1, SECTION 19 (D) OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION BY ADDING ANOTHER SUBSECTION THERETO TO PROVIDE FOR AMBULANCE FACILITIES TO BE LOCATED IN A C-1 ZONE PURSUANT TO A USE PERMIT, PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA,  
DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title II, Chapter I, Section 19 (D) of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition is hereby amended to read as follows:

11-1-19 (D) Additional Uses Permitted: The following uses may be permitted upon securing a special Use Permit as provided in Section 24 of this Chapter, except that the uses enumerated below may be permitted as a matter of right when in accordance with the exceptions shown below.

1. Automobile service stations for the sale of gasoline, oil and minor accessories only, where no repair work is done, except minor repairs made by the attendant and provided all lubrications, washing, repairing and storage are conducted within an enclosed permanent building.
2. Uses specifically permitted exclusively in the R-4 District.
3. Customer Operated Car Washes.
4. Lodging, boarding or rooming houses, hotels, motels, and other like tourist accommodations.
5. Emergency Ground Ambulance Facilities.

EXCEPTION: If an application for a reclassification to a C-1 zone under Section 25 of this Chapter includes any of the uses hereinabove enumerated, the approval of said application shall constitute approval of said use or uses and no special Use Permit shall be required; provided, however, that the notice of public hearing for reclassification shall specifically list said use or uses.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, paragraph, sentence, phrase, term, word or connotation of this ordinance, or portion thereof, is for any reason held invalid, inapplicable, or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such

holding shall not invalidate the remaining portions of this ordinance.
