

ORDINANCE NO. 1832

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE IV, CHAPTER 5, SECTION 8, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SUBSECTION (B) ENTITLED, "WINDOW SECURITY BARS", PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA,
DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title IV, Chapter 5, Section 8 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, is amended as follows:

4-5-8 EXITS

(B) Window Security Bars: No window in a sleeping room below the fourth floor shall be covered by exterior bars so as to preclude exit therefrom unless:

1. Such bars are equipped with a break-a-way device so that they can be opened from the interior of such bars.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, paragraph, sentence, phrase, term, word, or connotation of this ordinance, or portion thereof, is for any reason held invalid, inapplicable or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not invalidate the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or paragraph of this Chapter or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences,


clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.
