ORDINANCE NO. 1831

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE V, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 10(C)14, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, RELATING TO LICENSE FEES, BY DELETING THE REQUIREMENT FOR BUILDING CONTRACTORS AND SUB-CONTRACTORS TO POST A 'LICENSE BOND' WITH THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO, AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1: Title V, Chapter 1, Section 10(C)14 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended as follows:

5-1-10(C)14. [Before any license shall be issued hereunder the applicant therefor shall first obtain and file with the Director of License and Revenue a continuous surety bond, subject to cancellation only upon thirty (30) days prior written notice to the City, in the penal sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), executed by a surety company authorized to do business in the State. Such bond shall first be approved by the City Attorney as to form and legality thereof, and be conditioned that the licensee will comply with the provisions of all laws and regulations of the City, the rules and regulations of the Health Departments of the State and the City pertaining to the work done by the licensee, that the licensee will indemnify the City and all others for any loss sustained by reason of injury or damage to person or property in connection with or as a result of the work done by such licensee. In the event of any recovery upon such bond, the same shall be immediately restored to its original penal sum or a substitute bond furnished in the form and penal sum originally required. The bond for paving, macadamizing and excavation shall be in the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00)]


SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.



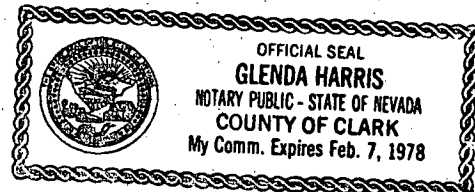

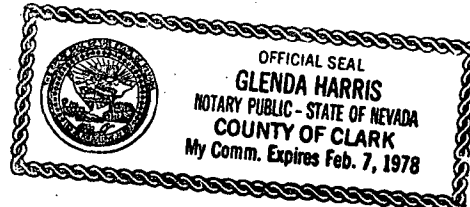
