

FIRST AMENDMENT

ORDINANCE NO. 1664

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE X, CHAPTER 17, SECTION 33, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION TO PROVIDE FOR PARKING ON CITY-OWNED OR CITY-LEASED LOTS; ADDING THERETO A NEW SUBSECTION DESIGNATED SUBSECTION (C), PROVIDING AUTHORITY FOR THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE TO HAVE VEHICLES TOWED AND IMPOUNDED AT THE EXPENSE OF THE REGISTERED OWNER OF SAID VEHICLE FROM CITY-OWNED OR CITY-LEASED PARKING LOTS; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title X, Chapter 17, Section 33, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

10-17-33

PARKING ON CITY-OWNED OR CITY-LEASED LOTS:

(A) The City Manager is hereby authorized to limit parking on City-Owned or City-Leased parking lots to certain specified persons, for [certain] designated purposes, and for certain specific lengths of time, and to erect signs giving notice of such limitations.

(B) When signs are erected giving notice thereof, it shall be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle [on such] on City-Owned or City Leased parking lots in violation of such limitations.

(C) The City Manager or his duly authorized representative shall have the authority to have any vehicle removed by towing and impounding from a City-Owned or City-Leased parking lot if such vehicle is found to be in violation of this section. All expenses incurred in the towing and impounding of such vehicle found to be in violation shall be the responsibility of and charged to the registered owner of said vehicle.


SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


