

ORDINANCE NO. 1663

AN ORDINANCE TO RE-ADOPT TITLE VI, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 34, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, PROVIDING THAT AN OFFENSE MADE A MISDEMEANOR BY THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA SHALL ALSO BE A MISDEMEANOR IN THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS WHENEVER SUCH OFFENSE IS COMMITTED WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF SAID CITY; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES, OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES, IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Nevada, by virtue of the Las Vegas City Charter, has granted to the Board of Commissioners of said City the power to declare by ordinance that any offense made a misdemeanor by the laws of the State of Nevada shall also be deemed to be a misdemeanor in the City of Las Vegas whenever such offense is committed within the boundaries of said City; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of said City has exercised such power, such ordinance to be found in Title VI, Chapter 1, Section 34, of the Municipal Code of said City; and

WHEREAS, many new criminal laws were enacted by the 1973 Session of the Nevada Legislature, which laws became effective July 1, 1973; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of said City desires by this ordinance to re-adopt said Title VI, Chapter 1, Section 34, to include within its purview all of such laws which became effective on July 1, 1973;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title VI, Chapter 1, Section 34, is hereby re-adopted.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code
