

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE I, CHAPTER 10, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA 1960 EDITION, BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SECTION DESIGNATED SECTION 4, PROVIDING THAT INVESTIGATORS OF THE CITY ATTORNEY MAY HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO ENFORCE THE CODE AND ARREST VIOLATORS; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title I, Chapter 10, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section designated Section 4 to read as follows:

1-10-4 The investigators of the city attorney shall have all of the authority vested in peace officers in the State of Nevada and the authority to enforce the laws of the City and those State laws made misdemeanors when committed within the City of Las Vegas, and shall have the power to arrest any person committing violations thereof.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, paragraph, sentence, phrase, term, word or connotation of this ordinance, or portion thereof, is for any reason held invalid, inapplicable, or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not invalidate the remaining portions of this ordinance.
