

ORDINANCE NO. 1639

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE VI, CHAPTER 11, SECTIONS 2 AND 3, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, 1960 EDITION, TO PROVIDE THAT IT BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON WITHIN THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS TO PROMOTE ANY OBSCENE MATERIAL AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; TO PROVIDE THAT IT BE UNLAWFUL TO EXHIBIT OBSCENE MOVIES IN THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title VI, Chapter 11, Sections 2 and 3 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1960 Edition, are hereby amended to read as follows:

6-11-2 It shall be unlawful for any person within the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, to promote any obscene material.

Any person violating any of the terms of this ordinance or failing or refusing to comply with the provisions hereof, shall be fined in the amount of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

The license of such person to operate such a business promoting any obscene material in the City of Las Vegas shall be suspended for a period of not less than five (5), nor more than sixty (60) days, after conformity with Title V, Chapter 1, Section 18, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1960 Edition.

6-11-3 It shall be unlawful for any person operating a business in the City of Las Vegas, and for any employees, including, but not limited to: ticket seller, ticket taker, usher, motion picture machine operator, and any other person, or independent contractor or agent, connected with or employed by such person, to exhibit or to show or exhibit or to aid or assist in the exhibition of any obscene motion picture, slide,

or exhibit in the City of Las Vegas.


Any person violating any of the terms of this ordinance or failing to comply with the provisions hereof, shall be fined in the amount of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

The license of such person to operate a movie theatre in the City of Las Vegas shall be suspended for a period of not less than five (5), nor more than sixty (60) days, after conformity with Title V, Chapter 1, Section 18, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1960 Edition.



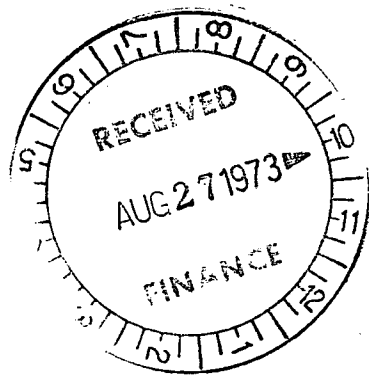
