

ORDINANCE NO. 1774

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE V OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY DELETING THEREFROM CHAPTER 23 ENTITLED, "ESCORT BUREAUS" AND ADDING THERETO A NEW CHAPTER 23 ENTITLED, "ESCORT BUREAUS"; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title V, Chapter 23 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby repealed to read as follows:

SECTION 2: The new Chapter 23 of Title V, entitled "ESCORT BUREAUS" shall read as follows:

CHAPTER 23

ESCORT BUREAUS

5-23-1: DEFINITIONS:

(a) Escort Bureau: Any business, agency or person who, for a fee, commission, hire, reward or profit, furnishes or arranges for persons to accompany other persons for companionship.

(b) Escort: Any person who, for a salary, fee, commission, hire, reward, or profit, makes himself available to the public for the purpose of accompanying other persons for companionship.

(c) Escort Patron: Any person who seeks the services of an escort bureau as defined herein.

5-23-2: MASCULINE - FEMININE; SINGULAR - PLURAL:

Whenever the masculine gender is used herein; the same shall also be construed to mean the feminine gender where appropriate in the context; wherever words are used in the singular herein they shall also be construed to mean the plural where appropriate in the context.

5-23-3: LICENSE REQUIRED:

(a) Escorts: No person or persons shall hold themselves out to the public as an escort, or accept compensation as an escort, without having first secured a license therefor from the Board of City Commissioners.

(b) Escort Bureau: No person, persons, partnership limited partnership, or corporation shall conduct, manage or carry on an escort bureau as defined herein without first having secured a license therefor from the Board of City Commissioners.

5-23-4:

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR ISSUANCE OF LICENSE:

(a) Escort: No person shall be issued a license as an escort unless he:

- (1) Has attained eighteen (18) years of age;
- (2) Is a resident of the State of Nevada
- (3) Is a citizen of the United States of America

(b) Escort Bureaus: No person, persons, partnership, limited partnership or corporation shall be issued an escort bureau license unless:

- (1) If an individual, he has attained the age of eighteen (18) years; or
- (2) If a partnership or limited partnership, all partners therein have attained the age of eighteen (18) years; or
- (3) If a corporation, the directors and all officers thereof have attained the age of eighteen (18) years; and
- (4) If an individual, he is a resident of the State of Nevada and a citizen of the United States of America; or
- (5) If a partnership or limited partnership, all of the partners thereof are residents of the State of Nevada and citizens of the United States of America; or
- (6) If a corporation, the directors and all of the officers thereof are residents of the State of Nevada and citizens of the United States of America; and
- (7) If a corporation, the corporation be qualified with the Secretary of the State of the State of Nevada to do business in the State of Nevada or be incorporated under the laws of the State of Nevada.

5-23-5:

PERSONS DISQUALIFIED FROM HOLDING ESCORT LICENSES:

No escort license shall be issued to any person who:

(a) Has been convicted of any offense which constitutes a felony under the laws of the State of Nevada or of the United States of America and who has not had his civil rights restored to him;

(b) Has been convicted of any offense within the seven years immediately preceding his application for an escort license which constitutes a gross misdemeanor under the laws of the State of Nevada or the United States of America;

(c) Has been convicted within three years immediately preceding his application for an escort license of any offense, other than traffic and parking violations, which constitutes a misdemeanor under the laws of the State of Nevada, its political subdivisions, or the United States of America.

5-25-6:

PERSONS NOT QUALIFIED TO HOLD ANY INTEREST IN AN ESCORT BUREAU

No escort bureau license shall be issued to any person, persons, partnership, limited partnership, or corporation, where any individual who holds a beneficial interest therein has:

(a) Been convicted of any offense which constitutes a felony under the laws of the State of Nevada or the United States of America and who has not had his civil rights restored to him;

(b) Been convicted of any offense within seven years immediately preceding the application for an escort bureau license which constitutes a gross misdemeanor under the laws of the State of Nevada or the United States of America;

(c) Been convicted within three years immediately preceding the application for an escort bureau license of any offense, other than traffic and parking violations, which constitutes a misdemeanor under the laws of the State of Nevada, its political subdivisions or the United States of America.

5-23-7:

APPLICATION FOR LICENSE:

(a) Escorts: All applications for an escort license shall be:

- (1) On application forms supplied therefor by the City of Las Vegas; and

- (2) In writing; and
- (3) Verified by the applicant personally before an officer of the License and Revenue Department of the City of Las Vegas; and
- (4) Contain such personal and background information on the applicant as may be deemed necessary to conduct a background investigation on applicant; and
- (5) Accompanied by an investigation fee in the amount of \$25.00; and
- (6) Accompanied by a three by five inch (3 x 5") picture of the head and shoulders of applicant; and
- (7) Deemed continuing and shall be updated within five (5) days of any change therein by the applicant except for the color of applicant's hair, height or weight.

(b) Escort Bureaus: All applications for an escort bureau license

shall:

- (1) Be on application forms supplied therefor by the City of Las Vegas; and
- (2) Be in writing; and
- (3) Be verified before an officer of the License and Revenue Department of the City of Las Vegas by applicant personally.

(a) If applicant is a partnership, or a limited partnership, the verifications of the license application shall be by a principal or managing partner;

(b) If a corporation, by a principal or managing officer thereof.

- (4) Contain such personal and background information on the applicant as shall be deemed necessary to conduct a background investigation on the applicant

- (a) If a partnership or limited partnership, such information shall be provided for all of the partners, including, if applicable, limited partners, the same as if each were sole proprietors and applicants;
 - (b) If a corporation, such information shall be provided for each of the stockholders, directors, and officers of such corporation the same as if each individual were a sole proprietor and applicant.
- (5) If a partnership or limited partnership, accompanied by a certified copy of an agreement or articles of partnership or limited partnership; and
- (6) If a corporation, accompanied by:
- (a) A certified copy of the articles of incorporation of such corporation, and, if incorporated under the laws of another state, a certificate of qualification to do business in the State of Nevada from the Secretary of the State of Nevada; and
 - (b) A current annual list of officers, directors and resident agent of such corporation; and
 - (c) A list of the stockholders, their last known residence addresses and telephone numbers, and their respective ownership interests in such corporation, certified as being true and correct by the secretary of such corporations; and
 - (d) A certified copy of a resolution by the Board of Directors of such corporation authorizing such license application and designating the officer to apply on such application and authorizing his verification thereof.
- (7) If such business is to be conducted under a name other than the legal name of the applicant, accompanied by a copy of any fictitious name certificate on file with the County Clerk of Clark County, Nevada;

(8) Payment of an investigation fee in the amount of \$250.00;
and

(9) Deemed continuing and shall be updated within fifteen
(15) days of any change therein except color of hair,
height and weight of applicant.

5-23-8:

FINGERPRINTS REQUIRED:

A. Escorts: Every applicant for an escort license shall allow
his fingerprints to be taken, which fingerprint record shall become a part
of his application.

B. Escort Bureaus: Every applicant for an escort bureau
license shall allow his fingerprints to be taken, which fingerprint record
shall become a part of his application;

1. If a partnership, or limited partnership, is the
applicant, each of the partners, including limited
partners, shall allow his fingerprints to be taken,
which fingerprint record shall become a part of the
partnership, or limited partnership, application.
2. If a corporation is the applicant, each of the officers
and directors shall allow his fingerprints to be taken,
which fingerprint record shall become a part of the
corporation applicant.

5-23-9

INCOMPLETE APPLICATION

No application for an escort license or an escort bureau license
shall be processed unless all of the information and/or documents and
fingerprints required by Sections 7 and 8 have been provided and any
acceptance of an incomplete application shall not be deemed a waiver of
the requirements of Sections 7 and 8 hereof and upon discovery of such
incompleteness, such application shall not be processed further until such
omitted information and/or documents shall have been provided by appli-
cant. Upon discovery of such incompleteness, the Division of License and
Revenue shall notify applicant, orally or in writing, of the particularities
of such incompleteness.

5-23-10:

INVESTIGATION REQUIRED:

Upon submission of a license application in accordance with
Sections 7 and 8 hereof, and payment of the investigation fee required in

Section 7, all applications for an escort or escort bureau license shall first be reviewed by an officer of the License and Revenue Division of the Department of Finance of the City of Las Vegas for completeness; if such application is complete in all respects, it shall then be referred to the Special Investigations Bureau of the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department for an investigation of the applicant, who shall return a written investigation report to the Board of the City of Las Vegas Commissioners at its next regularly scheduled meeting after completion of such investigation.

5-23-11

ISSUANCE OF LICENSE:

(a) Escorts: Upon completion of investigation, if the Board of City Commissioners shall be satisfied that such escort applicant shall possess the minimum qualifications required under Section 4 hereof, and shall not have been disqualified by Section 5 hereof, the Board of City Commissioners shall direct an escort license in the name of such escort for the escorts proposed employer be issued upon payment of a semi-annual license fee in the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).

(b) Escort Bureaus: Upon completion of investigation, if the Board of City Commissioners is satisfied that such applicant shall possess the minimum qualifications contemplated by Section 4(b) hereof and shall not be disqualified by the provisions of Section 6 hereof, the Board of City Commissioners shall direct an escort bureau license be issued to the applicant upon payment of a semi-annual license fee in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

5-23-12

NAME OF ESCORT BUREAU LICENSEE:

Every escort bureau license shall be issued in the name of:

- (a) if an individual or sole proprietor, in his name;
- (b) if a partnership or limited partnership, in the names of each of the partners, including limited partners;
- (c) if a corporation, in the name of the corporation.

5-23-13:

LICENSE FEES

All license fees contemplated herein shall be payable semi-annually.

5-23-14:

ESCORT LICENSE NOT TRANSFERABLE:

Every escort license shall be issued to the applicant for one escort bureau only; it shall be unlawful for an escort to undertake employment with any escort bureau other than the escort bureau for whom he is licensed.

(a) Transfer of Escort License: Upon a verified application, in writing, and payment of a transfer fee in the amount of \$5.00, an escort's license shall be transferred to the escort's new escort bureau employer.

(b) Surrender of Escort License: Upon termination of employment as an escort with his licensed escort bureau employer, every escort shall surrender his escort license to the City of Las Vegas within five (5) days of such termination of employment; it shall be unlawful for any escort to fail to surrender such license within the time prescribed.

5-23-15:

ESCORTS TO CARRY LICENSE AT ALL TIMES

Every escort shall carry his license on his person while in the course of his employment and shall present same to each person whom he is paid to accompany and shall present same at the request of any hotel security guard or officer of the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department.

5-23-16:

ESCORT BUREAU LICENSES:

(a) Every escort bureau license shall be issued for one (1) principal place of business which is defined as the location where the business is primarily conducted;

(b) Every escort bureau shall have a physically distinct principal place of business from every other escort bureau, that is, no two or more escort bureaus shall operate from the same office;

(c) No escort bureau shall operate from any location other than that for which its license is approved; upon proper application, an additional escort business license may be issued for an additional, or branch, location; the semi-annual license fee for such additional escort bureau license shall be in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

(d) Off-site Extension Telephones Prohibited: It shall be unlawful for any escort bureau licensed hereunder to use, cause to be used, or maintain, any off-site extension telephones in its business.

5-23-17:

ESCORT BUREAU LICENSE NOT TRANSFERABLE:

It shall be unlawful for an escort bureau licensed hereunder to conduct business at any location other than that for which its license

is issued; upon proper application, verified and in writing, and upon a finding that the proposed new location is suitably zoned for such business, and upon payment of a transfer fee in the amount of \$50.00, the escort bureau license shall be transferred to the proposed new location and all business activities of such escort bureau shall thereafter cease at the old location; it shall be unlawful for an escort bureau to commence business activities at its new proposed location prior to approval thereof and transfer of such escort bureau license.

5-23-18:

UNLAWFUL TO EMPLOY NON-LICENSED ESCORTS:

It shall be unlawful for any escort bureau to employ non-licensed escorts or to allow such non-licensed escorts to undertake employment until such escort's license shall have been presented to such escort bureau.

5-23-19:

DUTIES OF ESCORT BUREAUS - RE: ESCORTS:

Every escort bureau shall refer all prospective employees to the City of Las Vegas for licensing. Upon termination of employment of any escort with such escort bureau, such escort bureau shall notify City of Las Vegas, in writing, of such termination within five (5) days thereof.

5-23-20:

EMPLOYMENT RECORDS OF ESCORTS:

Every escort bureau licensed hereunder shall maintain the following records of employment of their employee escorts:

- (a) Date employment commenced; and
- (b) Date employment terminated; and
- (c) Names and addresses of all customers and the date and times their escorts are with such customers; and
- (d) Names of, and amounts paid by, customers for escorts.

The foregoing records shall be available to the City of Las Vegas upon written request therefor, and shall be open to the inspection of any officer of the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department upon request.

5-23-21:

GROUND FOR REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION OF LICENSE:

The Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas may revoke, suspend or take other action concerning any license issued hereunder upon satisfactory proof of any of the following:

- (a) Escorts:
 - (1) Conviction of any offense other than traffic and

parking violations, against the laws of the State of Nevada, any of its political subdivisions or the United States of America;

(2) Giving or making of false statements in the application for a license;

(3) Failure to surrender or apply for transfer of an escort license as required herein;

(4) Failure to update information required in the license application, as required herein.

(b) Escort Bureaus:

(1) If the licensee is a sole proprietor, conviction of any offense, other than traffic and parking violations, against the laws of the State of Nevada, any of its political subdivisions or the United States of America;

(2) If a partnership, limited partnership, or corporation, failure to remove any partner, officer, director or stockholder convicted of any offense, other than traffic and parking violations, against the laws of the State of Nevada, any of its political subdivisions, or the United States of America within three (3) months of the time of such conviction.

(3) Employment of a non-licensed escort;

(4) Failure to notify, in writing, of the termination of employment of any escort within five (5) days;

(5) Failure to keep records of employment of escorts as required herein;

(6) Failure to allow inspection of records required to be kept herein, by officers of the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department;

(7) Failure to make available to the City of Las Vegas, after written request therefor, records required to be kept herein;

(8) Giving or making of a false statement on the license application;

- (9) Termination of business operations at its licensed business location for a period in excess of ten (10) days;
- (10) Using, causing to be used, or maintaining an off-site extension telephone in connection with said business operations;
- (11) Failure to file with the County Clerk of Clark County, Nevada, a fictitious name certificate if such business is to be undertaken in any name other than that of the applicant;
- (12) Failure to update its license application as required herein;
- (13) Failure to pay any license fees due hereunder;
- (14) Failure to apply for change of business location prior to such change actually occurring;
- (15) Operating, or allowing to operate, another escort bureau from the same physical location for which the escort bureau license was issued.
- (16) The criminal conviction, other than traffic and parking violations, within two (2) years of each other, of two (2) or more of the escorts employed by the bureau, when it appears the criminal acts were committed while the escorts were providing a service to an escort patron.

5-23-22:

PROCEDURE FOR REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION OF LICENSE:

Except as provided herein, no license for an escort or an escort bureau shall be revoked or suspended except upon compliance with Chapter 27 of Title V of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1960 Edition, as amended from time to time.

5-23-23:

GROUND FOR DENIAL OF LICENSE:

- (a) Escorts: No escort license shall be issued hereunder unless:
 - (1) The requirements of Section 4(a) shall have been met;
 - (2) The applicant shall not be disqualified by the provisions of Section 5 hereof;
 - (3) The license application shall be complete in all respects.

(b) Escort Bureaus: No escort bureau license shall be issued unless:

- (1) The requirements of Section 4(b) hereof shall have been met, and
- (2) The applicant shall not be disqualified by the provisions of Section 6 hereof; and
- (3) The license application shall be complete in all respects; and
- (4) The proposed business location shall be zoned C-1.

5-23-24:

AUTOMATIC REVOCATION OF LICENSE OF ESCORT OR ESCORT BUREAU

(a) If any applicant for an escort license or for an escort bureau license shall make a false arrest statement as to previous convictions of him, or if a partnership, or limited partnership, of any of the partners (whether they be limited or not), or if a corporation of any officer, director or stockholder thereof, or of any manager of an escort bureau, upon discovery of the falsity of such statement, the license issued to such person, persons, or corporation shall automatically become null and void and such person, persons, or corporation shall terminate all business operations under such license within twenty-four (24) hours of notification, oral or written, of discovery of such statements.

(b) Any person, persons, or corporation believing themselves to be aggrieved by such automatic revocation to the Board of City Commissioners by filing, within five (5) days of such notification of discovery of falsity, with the City Clerk, a Notice of Appeal setting forth whether the revoked licensed was for an escort or an escort bureau, and a brief statement of the grounds for appeal.

(c) The Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, shall consider such appeal at its next regularly scheduled session and shall rule thereon at such meeting; at such meeting the Appellant shall have the right to appear, offer evidence and cross-examine any witnesses against him.

5-23-25:

CONVICTIONS OF ESCORT IMPUTED TO ESCORT BUREAU:


For the purposes of issuing, renewing or revoking the license of any escort bureau, the criminal convictions, other than traffic and parking violations, of the escorts employed by the bureau shall be imputed to the escort bureau when it appears that the criminal act was committed while the escort was providing a service to an escort patron.

SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.



SECTION 5: If any section, paragraph, sentence, phrase, term, word or connotation of this ordinance, or portion thereof, is for any reason held invalid, inapplicable, or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not invalidate the remaining portions of this ordinance.




