AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 238 OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGISTRATION AND OPERATION OF BICYCLES IN THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF".
