Ordinance No. 8, of the City of Las Vegas

Ordinance No. 8

An Ordinance to Prohibit Gross Intoxication in Public Places in the City of Las Vegas, Nevada.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do ordain:

Gross intoxication upon the public streets, or in hotels, saloons, store or other public places in the City of Las Vegas, is hereby prohibited, and any person found upon any public street in said City, or in any public place therein, in a state of gross intoxication, shall be guilty of a violation of this ordinance, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment not exceeding six months or by both such fine and imprisonment; and in case of default in the payment of any fine imposed for a violation of this ordinance it is hereby provided that the person upon whom such fine shall be imposed shall be imprisoned for one day for each two dollars (\$2.00) of such fine, and provided further, that any person imprisoned for a violation of the provisions of this ordinance may be compelled to work upon any public work in said City and whenever advisable a chain gang may be formed and worked.

The foregoing ordinance was read in full to the Board. After due consideration by the Board it was, upon motion of Commissioner Stewart, seconded by Commissioner McGovern and duly carried ordered that the foregoing ordinance be adopted as read and the clerk instructed to have the same published as by law provided, the vote being cast as follows:
