## Ordinance No. 11

An Ordinance To Prevent the Carrying of Concealed Weapons in the City of Las Vegas.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do ordain:

Any person who shall within the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, carry concealed upon his or her person any revolver, pistol, dagger, dirk, or brass knive, or any other weapon capable of inflicting bodily injury upon the person of any person shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding two hundred dollars, or be imprisoned in the city jail for any period of time not exceeding one hundred days.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.

Upon motion of Stewart, and seconded by Coughlin it was unanimously voted by the entire board that this ordinance be an emergency ordinance.
