Ordinance No. 14

An Ordinance Defining and Prohibiting Assault and Battery.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do ordain:

Section 1. An assault in an unlawful attempt, coupled with a present ability to commit a violent injury to the person of another, and any person convicted thereof shall be subject to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars.

Section 2. Assault and battery the unlawful beating of another person and any person convicted thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding one hundred and fifty dollars, or imprisoned in the city jail for any period not exceeding ninety days, or both such fine and imprisonment.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.

Upon motion of Von Tobel seconded by Stewart it was unanimously voted by the board that this be an emergency ordinance. The vote being cast as follows:
