Ordinance No. 16

An Ordinance to License Shows, Circuses, Menageries and Other Exhibitions in the City of Las Vegas.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do ordain:

Section 1. Any proprietor, lessee or manager of any show, menagerie, hippodrome or circus intending to exhibit any performance or exhibition in the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, shall pay to the City Treasurer of said City the sum of twenty-five dollars as a license fee for the privilege of showing and exhibiting such show, menagerie, hippodrome or circus for one day.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation who shall hold or exhibit any show, menagerie, circus, or hippodrome in the City of Las Vegas without first having paid the license mentioned and provided for in Section 1 hereof, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and be subject to a fine of not more than one hundred dollars and not less than one hundred dollars, or be imprisoned in the City Jail of said City for any period not exceeding one hundred days.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.

Upon motion of Von Tobel, seconded by Stewart, it was unanimously voted by the entire board that this ordinance be an emergency ordinance. The vote being cast as follows:
