Ordinance No 86

An Ordinance to amend Section six (6) and to repeal Section seven (7) of Ordinance No. 66 of the City of Las Vegas, entitled "An Ordinance Regulating Travel and Traffic upon the Public Streets of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada."

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section six (6) of said Ordinance No. 66 is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 6. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride or drive, or cause to be ridden or driven, any horse or other animal; or to ride, drive or propel, or cause to be ridden, driven or propelled, any vehicle at a rate of speed greater than fifteen miles per hour in, upon or along the public highways, streets, roads, alleys, lanes, ~~avenues~~, boulevards, strips, paths or squares within the limits of the City of Las Vegas.

Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than Ten Dollars nor more than One Hundred Dollars, or by imprisonment in the City Jail for a period of not less than Five Days nor more than Fifty Days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 2. Section seven (7) of said Ordinance No. 66 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after it's passage and publication for a period of one week (one issue) in Nevada County Review, a weekly newspaper printed and published in the City of Las Vegas, Nevada.
