

Ordinance No. 128

An Ordinance providing for the licensing of electrical workers in the City of Las Vegas, and fixing a penalty for the violation thereof.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 1. No person or persons, firm or corporation, shall engage in the business of installing electrical wiring or electrical apparatus within any building in the City of Las Vegas, for use in connection with electric light, heat, or power, without having first paid the annual city license herein provided.

Such license shall be as follows:

Subdiv. 1. For every such business where the same is carried on at a fixed place of business in said City of Las Vegas, in carrying on such business, per annum, \$25.00.

Subdiv. 2. For every kind of <sup>such</sup> business other than that described in Subdivision 1 of this Section, per annum, \$50.00.

Such license shall be issued by the City Clerk upon application being made therefor, and shall be payable in advance.

Such license shall entitle the holder thereof to engage in the business of installing electrical wiring and apparatus inside buildings, for use in connection with electrical light, heat, or power within the limits of the City of Las Vegas

Provided, that the provisions of this Section shall not apply to the lessee or owner of any premises where such owner or lessee shall personally perform the installation of such electrical wiring or electrical apparatus upon the premises owned or leased by him, as the case may be.

Sec. 2. Any person, or officer, superintendent, manager, or agent of any corporation, partnership, company, or association violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not less than <sup>ten dollars</sup> (\$10.00), nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00), or by imprisonment in the City Jail of said City for any period not less than five (5) days, nor more than six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Sec. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from

**ORDINANCE NO. 128**

 Provided, that the provisions of this Section shall not apply to the lessee or owner of any premises where such owner or lessee shall personally perform the installation of such electrical wiring or electrical apparatus upon the premises owned or leased by him, as the case may be.  
 Sec. 2. Any person or officer, superintendent, manager or agent of any corporation, copartnership, company, or association violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten dollars (\$10.00), nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00), or by imprisonment in the City Jail of said City for any period not less than five (5) days, nor more than six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.  
 Sec. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and adoption and publication for one week (two issues), in the Las Vegas Age, a semi-weekly newspaper published
