

ORDINANCE NO. 157

An Ordinance authorizing the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, to borrow ~~Forty nine thousand five~~

Hundred ninety-five and 12/100 Dollars (\$49,595.12)

to cover certain unpaid assessments heretofore levied and confirmed by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas for the purpose of paying for the work of making improvements in the City of Las Vegas, by grading for and construction of Asphaltic Concrete Pavements Durite Process on certain streets and portions of streets in said City, to-wit: On Main street, First Street, Second Street, Third Street, Fourth Street, Lewis Street, Clark Street, Bonneville Street and Garces Street, to issue and sell the bonds of the City of Las Vegas therefor, said Bonds to be known as "Las Vegas Special 1930 Pavement Improvement Bonds, Series C," and providing for the collection of said unpaid assessments by dividing the same into ten (10) annual installments and placing said installments on the Tax Roll of Clark County and collecting same in the same manner as State and County taxes are collected by law:

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS; DO ORDAIN, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That for the purpose of paying for the work of grading for and construction of Asphaltic Concrete Pavements Durite Process on certain streets and portions of streets in the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, on to-wit: portions of Main street, First street, Second street, Third street, Fourth street, Lewis Street, Clark street, Bonneville street and Garces street, in the City of Las Vegas, County of Clark, State of Nevada; for which special assessments have heretofore been levied and confirmed by the Board of City Commissioners and not paid in full by certain owners of property on said streets heretofore named, and in compliance with and by virtue and authority of a certain Act of the Legislature of the State of Nevada, approved March 13, 1909, entitled "An Act to authorize municipalities to issue bonds for the purpose of paying the cost of municipal improvements for which special assessments are levied," as amended by a certain Act of the Legislature approved March 13, 1913, entitled "An Act to amend Sections 1 and 2 of an Act entitled 'An Act to authorize municipalities to issue bonds for the purpose of paying the cost of municipal improvements for which special assessments are levied', approved March 13, 1909, and other matters relating thereto", and in accordance with City Ordinance No. 149, approved the 5th day of December, 1929, entitled "An Ordinance declaring the determination of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas to make certain improvements in the City of Las Vegas by grading for and constructing Asphaltic Concrete Pavement-Durite Process on certain streets and portions of streets in said City; describing definitely the location of said improvements; providing that the cost and expense thereof shall be paid entirely by special assessment upon all the lots included in the special assessment district, hereby established, according to benefits, except where, by the Charter of the City of Las Vegas certain portions thereof are required to be paid from the general fund of said City of Las Vegas; providing for the issuance of special assessment bonds and also general bonds of the City of Las Vegas for the payment thereof and other matters relating thereto," and City Ordinance No. 151, approved the 2nd day of January, 1930, entitled "An Ordinance empowering and directing the Ex-Officio City Assessor of the City of Las Vegas, County of Clark, State of Nevada, to levy a special assessment to defray the costs of making certain improvements in the City of Las Vegas, by grading for and construction of Asphaltic Concrete Pavements Durite Process on certain streets and portions of streets in said City, according to the plats, diagrams and estimates of cost thereof on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Las Vegas; describing definitely the location of said improvements, stating the amounts of said assessment, and designating the lots, lands and premises to be assessed according to benefits; providing for the issuance of special assessment bonds for the payment thereof, and other matters relating thereto," and in accordance with the Provisions of the Charter

of the City of Las Vegas, as amended by an Act of the Legislature of the State of Nevada, approved March 26, 1927, and in compliance with and by virtue and authority of a certain Act of the Legislature of the State of Nevada, approved March 23, 1927, entitled "An Act relating to bonds issued by counties, cities, towns, school districts, and other municipal corporations, and repealing all acts and parts of acts in conflict therewith;"

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS is hereby authorized and empowered to issue in the name of said City ~~Forty~~ 40 (40) bonds of the denomination of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) each, and ten (10) bonds of the denomination of nine hundred fifty nine & 51/100 dollars (959.51) of said bonds of the denomination of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) each and One (1) bond of the denomination of nine hundred fifty nine & 51/100 dollars (959.51) each, payable at annual periods of from one to ten years from January 1, 1930, each bearing interest at the rate of not to exceed seven per cent. per annum; said interest to be payable annually on the first day of January of each year; which said bonds shall be sold to the bidder making the best bid, but shall not be sold for less than par value and accrued interest.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners of said City shall cause said bonds to be prepared and they shall be signed by the Mayor or Mayor Pro Tem, and the City Clerk, and countersigned by the City Treasurer and authenticated by the seal of the City of Las Vegas. Coupons representing the several installments of interest to fall due thereon shall be attached to each bond so that they may be removed, without injury to the same, numbered consecutively, and bear the signature or facsimile signature of the Mayor or Mayor Pro Tem and countersignature of the City Treasurer. Said bonds shall be dated January 1, A. D., 1930, and shall be sold at not less than their face or par value and accrued interest, and the proceeds thereof shall be placed in the General Fund of the City of Las Vegas, to replace the money heretofore paid out of said General Fund for making said improvement, by reason of the non-payment of certain Special Assessments by certain of the property owners at the time required by law. The said bonds shall be known as and called "Las Vegas Special 1930 Pavement Improvements Bonds, Series C."

Section 3. The amount remaining unpaid of said Special Assessments for which these bonds are to be issued, as shown by the Assessment Roll on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Las Vegas appears to be

Forty nine thousand five hundred ninety five & 12/100  
Dollars (\$49,595.12), and said bonds and the said annual installments due and to become due thereon for Ten (10) annual periods commencing January 1, 1931, are and shall be a lien upon the lots and parcels of land hereinafter particularly described, for the amounts of the assessments due thereon, together with interest at the rate of not to exceed seven (7%) per annum from the first day of January, 1930, until said bonds are paid, the exact amount of interest on said bonds to be fixed and determined at the rate offered by the successful bidder on said bonds, as provided by law, and the interest on said installments of said unpaid assessments to be fixed by appropriate action of said Board of City Commissioners at the same rate as the interest payable on said bonds. (7%) per annum; each of said installments shall bear interest at the rate of seven per cent (7%) per annum, payable annually in the manner hereinafter directed, on the whole amount due and unpaid. Such installments and the interest thereon shall be and remain a lien on the said lots and parcels of land until paid in full, and shall be collected and paid in the following manner:

Each installment, together with the interest thereon, shall be placed on the Tax Roll of Clark County on and against the several owners and premises hereinbefore enumerated, and the County Assessor of Clark County, acting ex-officio Assessor of the City of Las Vegas, is hereby authorized and directed to enter the same on the said Tax Roll of Clark County and to extend the same in a special column for special assessments on the said Tax Roll of Clark County, and the County Treasurer, acting ex-officio City Treasurer, and Tax Collector of the City of Las Vegas, is hereby authorized and directed to collect the same, all in the same manner and at the same time as other State and County taxes are collected. Provided, that the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, shall annually, commencing with the year 1931, and continuing for a period of nine (9) years thereafter, and until all of said bonds are paid, at the time prescribed by law for the levying of taxes for State and County purposes, direct the City Clerk to report to the County Assessor, acting ex-officio City Assessor, a description of such lots and premises together with their owners as in Section 3 hereinbefore set forth, with the amount of the annual installments, together with the interest due thereon to be levied upon and against each of the same premises and owners and the City Assessor is hereby authorized and directed to enter the several sums so assessed as a tax upon the several lots or premises respectively, and the Board of City Commissioners shall annually continue to so require the City Assessor to enter the said installments of special assessments until the whole sum assessed with interest thereon has been paid. Provided further, however, that if the Board of City Commissioners should fail or neglect to direct the City Clerk to report to the City Assessor a description of such lots and premises as in this section before mentioned, the City Assessor shall enter the said special assessments and place the same on the said tax roll and do all and every thing necessary, as fully and completely as though the Board of City Commissioners had directed the same to be done.

Section 5. Said installments of special taxes and the interest thereon when collected, shall constitute and be a sinking fund for the payment of said bonds and the interest thereon, and said fund shall not be used for any other purpose, and as said installments with the interest thereon are paid, as hereinbefore directed, said bonds and the coupons thereon, shall be called in and paid, and cancelled by the City Treasurer, in their numerical order annually, to the amount and extent of such annual payments of the assessments, and the said interest on said bonds shall cease.

Section 6. The issuance of the bonds herein provided for shall be conclusive evidence of the regularity of all proceedings up to the issuance of such bonds, and in the event that the fund created by such special assessments shall be insufficient to pay the said bonds as they become due, the deficiency, if any, shall be paid by the City Treasurer, of the City of Las Vegas, out of the General Fund of said City and each of the bonds issued under this ordinance shall contain a provision to that effect and said bonds shall be exempt from City taxation.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after its adoption, approval and publication in the Las Vegas Age, a tri-weekly newspaper published in the City of Las Vegas for one week.

Section 8. The City Clerk and Clerk of the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas is hereby authorized and directed to have this ordinance published in the Las Vegas Age, a tri-weekly newspaper published in the City of Las Vegas, for one week.

ORDINANCE No. 157

An Ordinance authorizing the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, to borrow Forty Nine Thousand Five Hundred Ninety-five and 12/100 Dollars (\$49,595.12) to cover certain unpaid assessments heretofore levied and confirmed by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas for the purpose of paying for the work of making improvements in the City of Las Vegas, by grading for and construction of Asphaltic Concrete Pavements Durite Process on certain streets and portions of streets in said City, to-wit: On Main Street, First Street, Second Street, Third Street, Fourth Street, Lewis Street, Clark Street, Bonneville Street and Garces Street, to issue and sell the bonds of the City of Las Vegas therefor, said Bonds to be known as "Las Vegas Special 1930 Pavement Improvement Bonds, Series C," and providing for the collection of said unpaid assessments by dividing the same into ten (10) annual installments and placing said installments on the Tax Roll of Clark County and collecting same in the same manner as State and County taxes are collected by law.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. SECTION 4. That the unpaid assessments shall be paid as follows: One-tenth, on or before one year from the 1st day of January, 1930, and one-tenth on or before the 1st day of January of each year thereafter, until the same is paid in full with interest thereon at the rate of seven per cent. (7%) per annum; each of said installments shall bear interest at the rate of seven per cent. (7%) per annum, payable annually in the manner hereinafter directed, on the whole amount due and unpaid. Such installments and the interest thereon shall be and remain a lien on the said lots and parcels of land until paid in full, and shall be collected and paid in the following manner:

Each installment, together with the interest thereon, shall be placed on the Tax Roll of Clark County on, and against the several owners and premises hereinbefore enumerated, and the County Assessor of Clark County, acting ex-Officio Assessor of the City of Las Vegas, is hereby authorized and directed to enter the same on the said Tax Roll of Clark County and to extend the same in a special column for special assessments on the said Tax Roll of Clark County, and the County Treasurer, acting ex-Officio City Treasurer, and Tax Collector of the City of Las Vegas, is hereby authorized and directed to collect the same, all in the same manner and at the same time as other State and County taxes are collected. Provided, that the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, shall annually, commencing with the year 1931, and continuing for a period of nine (9) years, thereafter, and until all of said bonds are paid, at the time prescribed by law for the levying of taxes for State and County purposes, direct the City Clerk to report to the County Assessor, acting ex-officio City Assessor, a description of such lots and premises together with their owners as in Section 3 hereinbefore set forth, with the amount of the annual installments, together with the interest due there-

on to be levied upon and against each of the same premises and owners and the City Assessor is hereby authorized and directed to enter the several sums so assessed as a tax upon the several lots or premises respectively, and the Board of City Commissioners shall annually continue to so require the City Assessor to enter the said installments of special assessments until the whole sum assessed with interest thereon has been paid. Provided further, however, that if the Board of City Commissioners should fail or neglect to direct the City Clerk to report to the City Assessor a description of such lots and premises as in this section before mentioned, the City Assessor shall enter the said special assessments and place the same on the said tax roll, and do all and every thing necessary, as fully and completely as though the Board of City Commissioners had directed the same to be done.

Section 5. Said installments of special taxes and the interest thereon when collected, shall constitute and be a sinking fund for the payment of said bonds and the interest thereon, and said fund shall not be used for any other purpose, and as said installments with the interest thereon are paid, as hereinbefore directed, said bonds and the coupons thereon, shall be called in and paid, and cancelled by the City Treasurer, in their numerical order annually, to the amount and extent of such annual payments of the assessments, and the said interest on said bonds shall cease.

Section 6. The issuance of the bonds herein provided for, shall be conclusive evidence of the regularity of all proceedings up to the issuance of such bonds, and in the event that the fund created by such special assessments shall be insufficient to pay the said bonds as they become due, the deficiency, if any, shall be paid by the City Treasurer, of the City of Las Vegas, out of the General Fund of said City and each of the bonds issued under this ordinance shall contain a provision to that effect and said bonds shall be exempt from City taxation.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after its adoption, approval and publication in the Las Vegas Age, a tri-weekly newspaper published in the City of Las Vegas for one week.

Section 8. The City Clerk and Clerk of the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas is hereby authorized and directed to have this ordinance published in the Las Vegas Age, a tri-weekly newspaper published in the City of Las Vegas for one week.
