ORDINANCE NO. 28.

An Ordinance regulating and prohibiting displays in Moving Picture Shows.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 1. From and after the passage and publication of this ordinance it shall be unlawful for any owner, manager, lessee or anyone having charge of or conducting a moving picture show in the city of Las Vegas to show, display, project or exhibit within a showhouse or place of business frequented by the public upon a curtain, canvas or other object by means of a moving picture machine or similar contrivance, or to allow to be shown, displayed, projected or exhibited within a show house or place of business frequented by the public upon a curtain canvass or other object by means of a moving picture machine or similar contrivance, and by means of slides, films or similar device, any picture, sign announcement or advertisement relating to or advertising any saloon, saloon business, or house of ill fame, situated or conducted within the city of Las Vegas.

Sec. 2. Any person violating or willfully non-complying with any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than fifty dollars for each offense, or by imprisonment in the city jail until such fine is paid, not exceeding one day for each two dollars of such fine. in case such fine is not paid; and upon complaint and proof that any owner, manager, lessee or anyone having charge of or conducting any such place above described repeatedly violates this ordinance or any of the provisions thereof, the license for such place of business may be revoked by the board of city commissioners.

The necessity appearing to the board that an emergency existed it was upon motion of McGovern and seconded by Stewart ordered that this ordinance be passed as an emergency ordinance, the vote being cast as follows to-wit:—Coughlin, aye; Stewart, aye; McGovern, aye; Von Tobel, aye, and his Honor the Mayor Peter Buol, aye.

Passed by the board of commissioners this 3rd day of April, 1912, upon the following vote: Commissioners Coughlin, aye; Stewart aye, McGovern, aye; Von Tobel, aye, and his Honor the Mayor Peter Buol, aye.
