10 PROVIDING ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS FOR ELECTRICAL INSTALLATION,  
11 FIXING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REPEALING ORDIN-  
12 ANCE NUMBER 156 OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, ENTITLED, 'AN ORDINANCE  
13 REGULATING THE BUSINESS OF DOING ELECTRICAL INSTALLATION, FIXTURE  
14 AND CONNECTION WORK, AND PROVIDING FOR THE EXAMINATION OF PERSONS  
15 ENGAGED IN THE SAME, AND CREATING AN EXAMINATION BOARD, AND PRO-  
16 VIDING A PENALTY FOR A VIOLATION THEREOF', AND REPEALING  
17 ORDINANCE NUMBER 128 OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, ENTITLED, 'AN  
18 ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF ELECTRICAL WORKERS IN  
19 THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, AND FIXING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION  
20 THEREOF', AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES  
21 IN CONFLICT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE," APPROVED  
22 JULY 14TH, 1930, AND AMENDED SEPTEMBER 17TH, 1931 BY ORDINANCE  
23 NUMBER 174, AND REPEALING SECTION 5 OF SAID ORDINANCE NUMBER 161  
24 AS AMENDED.

25 The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas  
26 do ordain as follows:

27 Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 161 of the  
28 City of Las Vegas, as amended by Ordinance No. 174 of the City  
29 of Las Vegas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

30 "On and after the passage, adoption and completion  
31 of publication of this Ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any  
32 master electrician to do, or attempt to do, or cause to be done,  
except as hereinafter provided, any electrical installation,  
fixture or connection work, whether original work or alteration,

1 within any building in the City of Las Vegas, without first  
2 undergoing before the Electrical Inspector of the City of Las  
3 Vegas, or such other person or persons as may be named therefor  
4 by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, an  
5 examination as to his competency as an electrician or electrical  
6 worker and procuring from said Board of Commissioners a certifi-  
7 cate reciting that he has been found qualified to act in such  
8 capacity and to do said class of work. Such certificate shall  
9 be signed by the Mayor and by the Electrical Inspector."

6 Section 2. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 161 of the  
7 City of Las Vegas is hereby amended to read as follows:

8 "Any certificate issued under the provisions of Section  
9 One of this Ordinance, may be cancelled and annulled by the Board  
10 of Commissioners of said City, whenever it appears to said Board  
11 that the holder of such certificate, or any person working under  
12 him, has done, or habitually does any work or causes or permits  
13 or allows to be done any work not in strict accordance with ap-  
14 proved electrical methods as defined by any Ordinance of the City  
15 of Las Vegas, or which said Board of Commissioners may regard as  
16 dangerous to life or property, and it shall be unlawful for any  
17 person whose certificate has been so cancelled or annulled, to  
18 again engage in such work until he has been reinstated by said  
19 Board and a new certificate issued to him."

14 Section 3. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 161 of the  
15 City of Las Vegas, as amended by Ordinance No. 174 of the City  
16 of Las Vegas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

17 "Before or at the time of applying for such certificate,  
18 the applicant shall pay unto the City Clerk a fee of Fifty  
19 Dollars (\$50.00) and said Board of Commissioners will thereafter  
20 and as soon as practicable and in no event later than fifteen  
21 (15) days thereafter, arrange for such examination. Any person  
22 failing to pass any such examination shall be entitled to have  
23 returned to him the said sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), but any  
24 person failing to pass such examination shall not be permitted  
25 to take another examination at an earlier time than thirty days  
26 after the last preceding examination so taken by him, unless  
27 otherwise prescribed by an order of said Board of Commissioners."

23 Section 4. Section 4 of Ordinance No. 161 of the City  
24 of Las Vegas, as amended by Ordinance No. 174 of the City of  
25 Las Vegas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

26 "The word "person" as used herein shall include also  
27 any firm of persons or corporation. A "master electrician"  
28 within the meaning of this Ordinance is a person, firm or corpor-  
29 ation actively engaged in the business of installing, altering,  
30 and/or repairing electrical wiring of electrical lighting or  
31 heating apparatus for others, directly or by means of agents or  
32 employees; provided, however, that in the case of a firm or  
33 corporation engaging in the business of electrical work as afore-  
34 said the provisions of this ordinance relative to certificate of  
35 qualification shall be deemed to be complied with if the member  
36 of such firm, officer of such corporation, foreman or other  
37 person in charge of such electrical work for such firm or corp-  
38 oration, shall have complied with the requirements hereof and

1 received a certificate as a master electrician; but nothing  
2 herein shall be deemed to permit any person to have charge of,  
3 exercise any control over or direct any such electrical work  
4 without having obtained and having in force and effect a certifi-  
5 cate as herein provided for.

6 Provided, that none of the provisions of this Ordinance  
7 shall prevent the lessee or owner of any premises from per-  
8 forming his own electrical work on such premises with his own  
9 hands only, but if any one is hired to do such work the person  
10 hired shall be a master electrician and not a journeyman elec-  
11 trician. All work so done by such lessee or owner shall be  
12 subject to inspection, the payment of inspection fees, and shall  
13 be done strictly in conformity with the Ordinances of the City  
14 of Las Vegas pertaining to electrical work.

15 A "Journeyman Electrician" within the meaning of this  
16 Ordinance is a person employed by a master electrician to super-  
17 vise under the control and direction of a master electrician  
18 the installing, altering and/or repairing of electrical lighting  
19 or heating apparatus or to do installing, altering and/or repair-  
20 ing of electrical wiring of electrical lighting or heating appar-  
21 atus.

22 It shall be unlawful for any journeyman electrician to  
23 do electrical work in the City of Las Vegas without first pro-  
24 curing a certificate therefor as herein provided. Every appli-  
25 cation for a certificate as journeyman electrician within the  
26 City of Las Vegas shall be made to the City Clerk, and the  
27 Board of Commissioners of said City shall thereupon arrange for  
28 an examination of said applicant either by the Electrical  
29 Inspector of said City or such other person or persons as may  
30 be named therefor by said Board of Commissioners, as to his  
31 qualifications and fitness for such work, and if, after such  
32 examination it shall be found that the applicant is qualified  
to do the work of journeyman electrician within the said City  
and properly install electrical wiring and electrical lighting  
and heating apparatus in accordance with the provisions of the  
then existing ordinances of the City of Las Vegas relating to  
such work, or properly supervise the installation of electrical  
wiring and electrical lighting and heating apparatus, a certifi-  
cate reciting that he is so qualified shall be issued to him,  
signed by the Mayor and by the Electrical Inspector. The fee  
for the examination for journeyman electrician shall be Five  
Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be paid to the City Clerk, at the time  
of making said application.

Every person of the age of twenty-one years or over,  
engaged in work as master electrician or journeyman electrician  
in the City of Las Vegas at the time of the taking effect of  
this Ordinance, shall apply for and receive a certificate of  
competency from said Board of Examination before continuing such  
work, but shall not be required to submit to examination in  
order to receive the same. The provisions for taking out license  
and for annual renewal of license of master electrician shall  
apply to the master electricians mentioned in this paragraph.  
In case of the revocation of a certificate of competency, as  
herein provided for, such person shall submit to and pass an  
examination for competency before such Board of Examination  
before being reinstated and having a new certificate issued to  
him. The revocation of certificate of competency of a journey-  
man electrician may be had in the same manner and with the same  
effect as hereinabove provided for the revocation of certificate  
of competency of master electrician."

1 Section 5. Section 5 of Ordinance No. 161 of the  
2 City of Las Vegas, is hereby repealed.

3 Section 6. Section 13 of Ordinance No. 161 of the  
4 City of Las Vegas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

5 "The Electrical Inspector shall issue written orders  
6 to the City Clerk for all permits, shall make inspections and  
7 shall keep a complete record of all orders for permits issued  
8 by him and all inspections made by him, and shall perform such  
9 other official duties as may be required under the provisions of  
10 this or any other Ordinance of the City of Las Vegas relating to  
11 electrical installations, alterations, and/or repairs. All fees  
12 for permits and privileges and licenses under this ordinance  
13 shall be paid directly to the City Clerk of said City of Las  
14 Vegas.

15 No electrical installation, fixture or connection work  
16 of any kind shall be commenced by any person, firm or corporation  
17 without first having obtained therefor, a permit under the pro-  
18 visions of this ordinance."

19 Section 7. Section 15 of Ordinance No. 161 of the  
20 City of Las Vegas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

21 "A fee of \$1.00 shall be charged for each survey of a  
22 proposed electrical installation, alteration or repair for  
23 which a permit has not first been issued, which amount shall  
24 be paid to the City Clerk by the person, firm or corporation  
25 responsible for each survey."

26 Section 8. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances  
27 in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

28 Section 9. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to  
29 have this Ordinance published in the Las Vegas EVENING  
30 REVIEW JOURNAL, a DAILY newspaper, published  
31 in the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, for a period of  
32 two weeks, that is to say, once each week for a period of two  
33 weeks.

"Any certificate issued under the provisions of Section One of this Ordinance, may be cancelled and annulled by the Board of Commissioners of said City, whenever it appears to said Board that the holder of such certificate, or any person working under him, has done, or habitually does, any work or causes or permits or allows to be done any work not in strict accordance with approved electrical methods as defined by any Ordinance of the City of Las Vegas, or which said Board of Commissioners may regard as dangerous to life or property, and it shall be unlawful for any person whose certificate has been so cancelled or annulled, to again engage in such work until he has been reinstated by said Board and a new certificate issued to him.

Section 3. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 161 of the City of Las Vegas, as amended by Ordinance No. 174 of the City of Las Vegas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Before or at the time of applying for such certificate, the applicant shall pay unto the City Clerk a fee of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) and said Board of Commissioners will thereafter, and as soon as practicable and in no event later than fifteen (15) days thereafter, arrange for such examination. Any person failing to pass any such examination shall be entitled to have returned to him the said sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), but any person failing to pass such examination shall not be permitted to take another examination at an earlier time than thirty days after the last preceding examination so taken by him, unless otherwise prescribed by an order of said Board of Commissioners.

Provided, that none of the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevent the lessee or owner of any premises from performing his own electrical work on such premises with his own hands only; but if any one is hired to do such work the person hired shall be a master electrician and not a journeyman electrician. All work so done by such lessee or owner shall be subject to inspection, the payment of inspection fees, and shall be done strictly in conformity with the Ordinances of the City of Las Vegas pertaining to electrical work.

A 'Journeyman Electrician' within the meaning of this Ordinance is a person employed by a master electrician to supervise under the control and direction of a master electrician the installing, altering and/or repairing of electrical lighting or heating apparatus.

It shall be unlawful for any journeyman electrician to do electrical work in the City of Las Vegas without first procuring a certificate therefor as herein provided. Every application for a certificate as journeyman electrician within the City of Las Vegas shall be made to the City Clerk, and the Board of Commissioners of said City shall thereupon arrange for an examination of said applicant, either by the Electrical Inspector of said City or such other person or persons as may be named therefor by said Board of Commissioners, as to his qualifications and fitness for such work, and if, after such examination, it shall be found that the applicant is qualified to do the work of journeyman electrician within the said City and properly install electrical wiring and electrical lighting and heating apparatus in accordance

with the provisions of the then existing ordinances of the City of Las Vegas relating to such work, or properly supervise the installation of electrical wiring and electrical lighting and heating apparatus, a certificate reciting that he is so qualified shall be issued to him, signed by the Mayor and by the Electrical Inspector. The fee for the examination for journeyman electrician shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be paid to the City Clerk at the time of making said application.

All fees for permits and privileges and licenses under this ordinance shall be paid directly to the City Clerk of said City of Las Vegas.

No electrical installation, fixture or connection work of any kind shall be commenced by any person, firm or corporation, without first having obtained therefor, a permit under the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 7. Section 15 of Ordinance No. 161 of the City of Las Vegas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"A fee of \$1.00 shall be charged for each survey of a proposed electrical installation, alteration or repair for which a permit has not first been issued, which amount shall be paid to the City Clerk by the person, firm or corporation responsible for each survey."

Section 8. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 9. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to have this Ordinance published in the Las Vegas Evening Review Journal, a daily newspaper, published in the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, for a period of two weeks, that is to say, once each week for a period of two weeks.
